Dear Valued Customers

It has been some time since we last communicated with you as not much has been happening in the world of travel. We currently have tours departing early in 2022 to New Zealand and Norfolk Island and we are excited to hear the government is talking about the re-opening of international borders in the coming months.

Of late, we have been receiving enquiries about when we will start selling international tours to other destinations. While we are eager to do this as soon as possible, we also have to balance this with the likelihood of the tour actually departing as planned. At present, there are questions which we don't have the answers to. Cancelling tours causes disappointment and frustration for customers, and a considerable financial cost for us. For these reasons we are hesitant to put on tours where we feel there is a reasonable possibility that they may later be cancelled.

We expect certain destinations to return earlier than others. We are currently working on a Singapore tour departing in May 2022. We are also considering tours to Japan, South Korea, Taiwan, Vietnam, Sri Lanka, Thailand and the UK for later in 2022. We look forward to adding more destinations to this list as circumstances permit, however we do not expect to be travelling to Africa or the US or tours involving multiple countries until 2023.

We will be working with our ground operators over the coming months to answer country-specific questions concerning possible outbreaks, vaccine requirements, testing, quarantines and social distancing measures to help keep our passengers safe and to comply with government regulations.
