

All meals are included on board the cruise ship

- 12.09.17** Depart Melbourne at 9.15am on QF 93, arriving in Los Angeles at 6.35am the same day (you cross the International Date Line).
Depart Sydney at 9.50am on QF 11, arriving in Los Angeles at 6.30am the same day (you cross the International Date Line).
Depart Brisbane at 10.00am on QF 15, arriving in Los Angeles at 6.00am the same day (you cross the International Date Line).
All passengers depart Los Angeles at 8.40am on QF 3729, arriving in Seattle at 11.10am (this flight is operated by Alaska Airlines).
Upon arrival in Seattle you are transferred to the Fairmont Olympic Hotel for a three night stay including breakfast.
- 13.09.17** Today there is an included city sightseeing tour, showing you the highlights of the city.
- 14.09.17** Today there is an included tour of the Boeing Factory.
- 15.09.17** Today you are transferred to the cruise terminal in Seattle to board the Celebrity Solstice for your Alaskan cruise. Ship departs Seattle at 5pm.
- 16.09.17** At sea.
- 17.09.17** Arrive Ketchikan, Alaska at 7am, departing at 4pm.
- 18.09.17** Scenic cruising of Tracy Arm Fjord between 6am and 10am. Then arrive Juneau, Alaska at 1.30pm, departing at 10pm.
- 19.09.17** Arrive Skagway, Alaska at 7am, departing at 6pm. Then cruise the Inside Passage between 6.30pm and 10.30pm.
- 20.09.17** At sea.
- 21.09.17** Arrive Victoria, Canada at 5.30pm, departing at 11.59pm.
- 22.09.17** Arrive Vancouver, Canada at 7am. After disembarking the cruise ship you are transferred to the Shangri-La Hotel in Vancouver for a three night stay with breakfast.
- 23.09.17** Today is at leisure in Vancouver.
- 24.09.17** Full day sightseeing tour to the mountain resort village of Whistler.

- 25.09.17** Today you are transferred to the train station to board the Rocky Mountaineer for the 2 day train journey to Banff, Silverleaf Service.
The Silverleaf Service allows you to enjoy oversized windows in each single level dome coach, as well as a hot gourmet breakfast and lunch served in your spacious seat. Included onboard is complimentary alcoholic and non alcoholic beverages and gourmet snacks throughout the journey.
The first day of the journey travels from the coastal city of Vancouver to Kamloops, in the heart of British Columbia's interior. On today's journey you will see dramatic changes in scenery from the lush green fields of the Fraser Valley, through forests and winding river canyons, surrounded by the peaks of the Coast and Cascade Mountains, to the desert-like environment of the BC interior. Highlights include the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon and the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River. Your day concludes as the Rocky Mountaineer travels along the shores of Kamloops Lake into Kamloops. Upon arrival in Kamloops you are transferred to your hotel for an overnight stay.
- 26.09.17** Today the train journey continues eastwards to the mighty Canadian Rockies and the Province of Alberta. Once again you will see a spectacular array of scenery as you travel across ranchlands, along rocky lakeshores, over high mountain passes and through the remarkable tunnels that form part of the rich rail history of the Canadian Rockies. Today's highlights include Craigellachie, where the last spike of the Canadian Pacific Railway was driven, the climb over Rogers Pass, Kicking Horse Canyon, the Spiral Tunnels and of course the glaciers and snow-capped peaks of the Canadian Rockies. Your rail journey ends this evening in the resort town of Banff. You have a two night stay at the Fairmont Banff Springs including breakfast.
- 27.09.17** Today is at leisure in Banff Springs.
- 28.09.17** Full day sightseeing tour of Banff and Yoho National Parks. You are transferred to Lake Louise for a two night stay at the Fairmont Chateau, including breakfast.
- 29.09.17** Full day sightseeing including an Ice Explorer ride onto the surface of the Athabasca Glacier at the Columbia Icefield.

Conditions for Alaska and the Rockies aboard the Celebrity Solstice

Deposits and Payments - A non-refundable deposit of \$3,500 per person is payable within 3 days of booking. This deposit is not refundable should you later cancel. The balance is payable in full 12 weeks prior to departure.

Refunds and Cancellations - Cancellations after final payment will result in a refund limited to whatever we can recoup from the airline.

Insurance - Adequate travel insurance is essential. We can arrange this for you if desired.

Passports - All travellers require a current passport with at least 6 months left on it at the end of the tour. Non-Australian passport holders require a re-entry visa for Australia. A visa waiver is required for travel to the United States of America for all Australian passport holders. The cost of the visa waiver is USD \$14 per person. Please note that Australians who have travelled to Iran, Iraq, Syria or Sudan since the 1st March 2011 or Australians who are dual citizens of these countries will no longer be eligible to apply for US visa waiver and will instead need to apply for a non-immigrant visa at a US Embassy or Consulate.

From the 15 March 2016 passengers entering Canada will require an Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA), which is applied for online and requires your passport details, credit card and an email address. The current cost for this ETA is \$7 Canadian Dollars and is valid for five years. No other visas are required for this program if you are travelling on an Australian passport.

Basic Tour Price and Taxes - Air taxes and fuel levies are included in the basic tour price if the tour is paid in full on or before the due date on the final invoice. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to charge for any increase in air taxes and fuel levies if the tour is not paid in full by the due date.

Not Included in the Cost - All items of a personal nature such as telephone calls, drinks, excess baggage, tips, meals, (except those specified in the itinerary), travel insurance etc. and airport transfers. Similarly, credit card payments can only be accepted if 2% is added to the price to help defray the heavy merchant fees charged to us by the credit card companies. There is a 3% surcharge for Diners Club.

Health and Fitness - Macleay Valley Travel recommends that the passenger is reasonably healthy and/or fit to participate in this tour. Persons with a disability requiring special assistance must be accompanied by a companion. Macleay Valley Travel and their representatives cannot provide this service. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to accept/decline or terminate a passenger's participation in the tour under certain circumstances.
