Itinerary for Grand Japan Springtime aboard Diamond Princess

Meals are included onboard the cruise ship.

- 23.03.19** Depart Sydney at 9.35pm on SQ 288, arriving in Singapore at 5.00am the next morning (24.03.19 – this flight goes via Canberra).
Depart Brisbane at 11.35pm on SQ 246, arriving in Singapore at 5.35am the next morning (24.03.19).
- 24.03.19** Melbourne passengers depart at 1.05am on SQ 218, arriving in Singapore at 5.45am. Depart Singapore at 8.05am on SQ 632, arriving in Tokyo (Haneda Airport) at 3.35pm.
Upon arrival in Tokyo you are transferred to the Intercontinental Hotel Tokyo Bay for a two night stay with breakfast daily. This 4.5 star hotel is located close to the Tsukiji Fish Market, Tokyo Tower, Tokyo Imperial palace and Tokyo Stock Exchange.
- 25.03.19** This morning enjoy a half day tour of Tokyo, taking in the major landmarks. First stop is to Tokyo Tower for a panoramic view of the city from the Observation Platform. Next is the Meiji Shrine, the finest example of Japanese shrine architecture. Then drive through the Akasaka Guest House, which is a magnificent western-style baroque palace. This is followed by a stop at the Imperial Palace Plaza and Double Bridge.
- 26.03.19** Today you will be transferred from your hotel to the cruise port to board the Diamond Princess. Ship departs Tokyo at 5.00pm.
- 27.03.19** Arrive Gamagori, Japan at 7am, departing at 4pm.
- 28.03.19** Arrive Osaka, Japan at 7am, departing at 6pm.
- 29.03.19** Arrive Kochi, Japan at 7am, departing at 6pm.
- 30.03.19** At sea.
- 31.03.19** Arrive Busan, South Korea at 7am, departing at 4pm.
- 01.04.19** At sea.
- 02.04.19** Arrive Yokkaichi, Japan at 7am, departing at 5pm.
- 03.04.19** Arrive Tokyo (Yokohama), Japan at 6am. After disembarking the ship, you are transferred to the airport for your flights home.

Deposits and Payments - A non-refundable deposit of \$2,500 per person is payable within 3 days of booking. This deposit is not refundable should you later cancel. The balance is payable in full 12 weeks prior to departure. Macleay Valley Travel often has to adhere to strict payment deadlines and your booking on the tour may be cancelled if final payment is not received by the due date, with no refund applicable.

Refunds and Cancellations - Cancellations after final payment will result in a refund limited to whatever we can recoup from the airline.

Insurance - Adequate travel insurance is essential. We can arrange this for you if desired.

Passports - All travellers require a current passport with at least 6 months left on it at the end of the tour.

Non-Australian passport holders require a re-entry visa for Australia. No visas are required for this cruise package if travelling on an Australian passport.

Basic Tour Price and Taxes - Air taxes and fuel levies are included in the basic tour price if the tour is paid in full on or before the due date on the final invoice. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to charge for any increase in air taxes and fuel levies if the tour is not paid in full by the due date.

Not Included in the Cost - All items of a personal nature such as telephone calls, drinks, excess baggage, tips, meals, (except those specified in the itinerary), travel insurance etc. and airport transfers. Similarly, credit card payments (Visa/MasterCard) can only be accepted if 1% is added to the price to help defray the heavy merchant fees charged to us by the credit card companies. There is a 2% surcharge for American Express.
