03.10.20 Australia – Los Angeles – Washington D.C.

Depart Brisbane at 6.00am on flight QF 501, arriving in Sydney at 7.35am.

Brisbane & Sydney passengers depart Sydney at 9.30am on flight UA 842, arriving in Los Angeles at 6.05am the same day (you cross the International Date Line).

Depart Melbourne at 9.30am on flight UA 99, arriving in Los Angeles at 6.40am (you cross the International Date Line).

Then depart Los Angeles at 8.20am on flight UA 2305, arriving in Washington D.C at 4.20pm. Upon arrival you are transferred to the Darcy Hotel or similar a two night stay.

05.10.20 Williamsburg, Virginia

Conditions for Historic America Fly, Tour & Cruise aboard Sky Princess

Deposits and Payments - A \$3,200 per person deposit is required within 2 days of booking for an inside cabin. This deposit may increase for a higher cabin category. This payment is not refundable should you later cancel.

The balance is payable in full 12 weeks prior to departure. Macleay Valley Travel often has to adhere to strict payment deadlines and your booking on the tour may be cancelled if final payment is not received by the due date, with no refund applicable.

Refunds and Cancellations - Cancellations after final payment will result in a refund limited to whatever we can recoup from the airline.

Airline Tickets - Please note that any changes made to airline tickets once they have been issued will likely incur high cancellation and/or reissue fees. These fees are typically set by the airline and are outside of our control.

Insurance - Adequate travel insurance is essential. We can arrange this for you if desired. Macleay Valley Travel offers Suresave Travel Insurance. Please note that we can only process your travel insurance when we have received full payment for the insurance and the signed Suresave Travel Insurance application form. Until this time the travel insurance cannot be processed and will not be valid. Macleay Valley Travel will bare no responsibility for any consequences that may occur as a result of an incomplete insurance application.

Passports - All travellers require a current passport with at least 6 months left on it at the end of the tour. Non-Australian passport holders require a re-entry visa for Australia. A visa waiver is required for travel to the United States of America for all Australian passport holders. The cost of the visa waiver is USD \$14 per person, subject to change. Please note that Australians who have travelled to Iran, Iraq, Syria, Sudan, North Korea or Venezuela since the 1st March 2011 or Australians who are dual citizens of these countries will no longer be eligible to apply for US visa waiver and will instead need to apply for a non-immigrant visa at a US Embassy or Consulate. No other visas are required if you are travelling on an Australian passport.

Basic Tour Price and Taxes - Air taxes and Fuel Levies are included in the basic tour price if the tour is paid in full on or before the due date on the final invoice. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to charge for any increase in Air taxes and Fuel Levies if the tour is not paid in full by the due date.

Not Included in the Cost - All items of a personal nature such as telephone calls, drinks, excess baggage, tips, meals, (except those specified in the itinerary), travel insurance etc. and airport transfers, unless stated in the itinerary. Similarly, credit card payments (Visa/MasterCard) can only be accepted if 1% is added to the price to help defray the heavy merchant fees charged to us by the credit card companies. There is a 2.75% surcharge for American Express.

Health and Fitness - Macleay Valley Travel recommends that the passenger is reasonably healthy and/or fit to participate in this cruise package. Persons with a disability requiring special assistance must be accompanied by a companion. Macleay Valley Travel and their representatives cannot provide this service.
