Upon arrival in Vancouver you will be transferred to the port to board the Grand Princess.

11.05.20 Arrive Ketchikan, Alaska at 6.30am, departing at 3pm.

12.05.20 Arrive Juneau, Alaska at 8am, departing at 9pm.

13.05.20 Arrive Skagway, Alaska at 7am, departing at 8.30pm.

14.05.20 Scenic cruising of Glacier Bay National Park between 6am and 3pm.

15.05.20 Scenic cruising of College Fjord between 6pm and 8.30pm.

16.05.20 (B/L/D) Arrive Anchorage Alaska and disembark the ship. You are transferred by train to the Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge for a two night stay.

21.05.20 Today you will be transferred to the airport for your flights home.
Depart Anchorage at 4.10pm on flight AC 539, arriving in Vancouver at 8.20pm.
Brisbane passengers depart Vancouver at 11.45pm on AC 35, arriving in Brisbane at 7.25am two days later (23.05.20 – you recross the International Date Line).
Sydney passengers depart Vancouver at 11.50pm on AC 33, arriving in Sydney at 8.20am two days later (23.05.20 – you recross the International Date Line).

Note: Gratuities have been included whilst on the cruise ship, but are not included for the guide and drivers for the land components. We recommend a gratuity of USD \$7 per person, per day, for the land components.

Conditions for Inside Passage and Magnificent Alaska Fly, Cruise & Tour

Deposits and Payments - A non-refundable deposit of \$3400 per person is payable within 3 days of booking. This deposit is not refundable should you later cancel. The balance is payable in full 13 weeks prior to departure. Macleay Valley Travel often has to adhere to strict payment deadlines and your booking on the tour may be cancelled if final payment is not received by the due date, with no refund applicable.

Refunds and Cancellations - Cancellations after final payment will result in a refund limited to whatever we can recoup from the airline.

Airline Tickets - Please note that any changes made to airline tickets once they have been issued will likely incur high cancellation and/or reissue fees. These fees are typically set by the airline and are outside of our control.

Insurance - Adequate travel insurance is essential. We can arrange this for you if desired.

Passports - All travellers require a current passport with at least 6 months left on it at the end of the tour. A visa waiver is required for travel to the United States of America for all Australian passport holders. At present the cost for a visa waiver is USD \$14 per person. Please note that Australians who have travelled to Iran, Iraq, Syria, Sudan, North Korea or Venezuela since the 1st March 2011 or Australians who are dual citizens of these countries will no longer be eligible to apply for US visa waiver and will instead need to apply for a non-immigrant visa at a US Embassy or Consulate. All passengers entering Canada will require an Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA), which is applied for online and requires your passport details, credit card and an email address. The current cost for this ETA is \$7 Canadian Dollars and is valid for five years. Visas prices are subject to change.

Basic Price and Taxes - Air taxes and fuel levies are included in the basic package price if paid in full on or before the due date on the final invoice. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to charge for any increase in air taxes and fuel levies if not paid in full by the due date.

Not Included in the Cost - All items of a personal nature such as telephone calls, drinks, excess baggage, tips, meals, (except those specified in the itinerary), travel insurance etc. and transfers not stated in the itinerary. Credit card payments (Visa/MasterCard) can only be accepted if 1% is added to the price to help defray the heavy merchant fees charged to us by the credit card companies.
