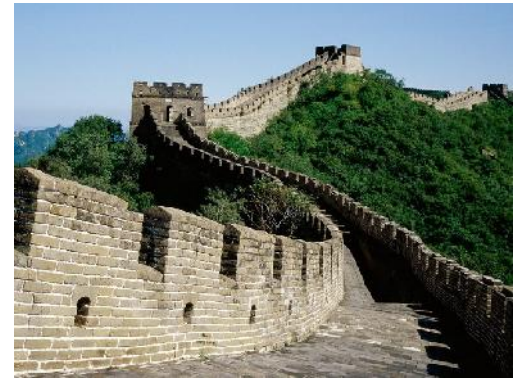

Depart Melbourne at 8.00am on QF 414, arriving in Sydney at 9.25am.

Depart Brisbane at 8.05am on QF 509, arriving Sydney at 9.40am.

All passengers depart Sydney at 12.10pm on QF 107, arriving in Beijing at 10.15pm. You are met at the airport and transferred to the hotel for a three night stay. Please note that a Chinese visa is required and needs to be obtained from Australia prior to departing on the tour.

Your tour today starts with a visit to Tiananmen Square, which is arguably claimed as the largest public square in the world. By walking through the square you enter the Forbidden City, the largest Imperial Palace in China and home to 24 Emperors who reigned during the 600 year Ming and Qing dynasties. In the afternoon enjoy a Kungfu Show, one of China's leading performing arts, followed by dinner.

After breakfast you will be transferred to visit the Mutianyu Great Wall of China. This is one of the best preserved sections of the Great Wall, and was first built in the 6th century. The visit includes a round-trip cable car ride and some free time to experience this outstanding achievement. Afterwards you are transferred back to Beijing. This evening enjoy a special Beijing Roast Duck dinner in Hua's Restaurant.

This morning is at leisure to explore Beijing. Around midday you are transferred to the railway station to take the high speed train to Xian. Upon arrival in Xian you are transferred to the hotel for a two night stay. This evening enjoy an included dinner.

Xian is one of the oldest cities in China and is the starting point for the ancient Silk Road. Today transfer to visit the famous Terracotta Warriors and Horses Museum. Afterwards drive back to the downtown area to visit the Big Wild Goose Pagoda Park, passing the Bell Tower and Drum Tower, and also visit the Muslim Quarters. Tonight enjoy an included Dumpling Banquet followed by a Tang Dynasty Singing & Dancing Show.

This morning you are collected from the hotel and transferred to the railway station to take the high speed train to Shanghai. Upon arrival in Shanghai you are met and

transferred to the hotel for a two night stay. The remainder of the day is at leisure.

Deposits and Payments - A non-refundable deposit of \$2200 per person is payable within 3 days of booking. This deposit is not refundable should you later cancel. The balance is payable in full 12 weeks prior to departure. Macleay Valley Travel often has to adhere to strict payment deadlines and your booking on the tour may be cancelled if final payment is not received by the due date, with no refund applicable.

Refunds and Cancellations - Cancellations after final payment will result in a refund limited to whatever we can recoup from the airline.

Airline Tickets - Please note that any changes made to airline tickets once they have been issued will likely incur high cancellation and/or reissue fees. These fees are typically set by the airline and are outside of our control.

Insurance - Adequate travel insurance is essential. We can arrange this for you if desired.

Passports - All travellers require a current passport with at least 6 months left on it at the end of the tour. Non-Australian passport holders require a re-entry visa for Australia. Visas are required for all Australian passport holders to China. Chinese Visa Application Service Centre (CVASC) charge Australian passport holders \$60 visa fee plus application service fee of \$71.50 and we charge \$30 for processing. Different visa fees apply to non Australian passport holders. A visa is also required for Vietnam which is obtained onboard the cruise ship at a current cost of USD \$56 per person. Please note that visas prices are subject to change.

Basic Tour Price and Taxes - Air taxes and fuel levies are included in the basic tour price if the tour is paid in full on or before the due date on the final invoice. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to charge for any increase in air taxes and fuel levies if the tour is not paid in full by the due date.

Not Included in the Cost - All items of a personal nature such as telephone calls, drinks, excess baggage, tips, meals, (except those specified in the itinerary), travel insurance etc. and transfers not stated in the itinerary. Similarly, credit card payments (Visa/MasterCard) can only be accepted if 1% is added to the price to help defray the heavy merchant fees charged to us by the credit card companies. There is a 2% surcharge for American Express.

Health and Fitness - Macleay Valley Travel recommends that the passenger is reasonably healthy and/or fit to participate in this tour. Persons with a disability requiring special assistance must be accompanied by a companion. Macleay Valley Travel and their representatives cannot provide this service. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to accept/decline or terminate a passenger's participation in the tour under certain circumstances.

Booking through other Agents - As we keep the cost of our tours as low as possible, there is insufficient margin for us to be able to pay commission to other travel agents, so some bookings can only be accepted if the client pays the other agent's commission.

Accreditation - Macleay Valley Travel is a fully accredited travel agency under the AFTA (Australian Federation of Travel Agents) ATAS - AFTA Travel Accreditation Scheme. As such, you are assured of a consumer focused and quality assured business, ensuring professional conduct and ethical business practices. We are happy for any prospective traveller with us to check us out with your local Consumer Affairs (Fair Trading) department.
