- 24.09.18** Depart Melbourne at 9.05am on flight Qantas flight QF 93, arriving in Los Angeles at 6.30am the same day (you cross the International Date Line).
Depart Sydney at 9.45am on Qantas flight QF 11, arriving in Los Angeles at 6.25am the same day.
Depart Brisbane at 10.20am on flight QF 15, arriving in Los Angeles at 6.00am the same day.
Upon arrival you are transferred to the Hilton Waterfront Beach Resort or similar for a two night stay.

- 26.09.18** Today you are transferred to the cruise terminal to embark on the Island Princess. Ship departs at 4pm.

Sydney passengers depart Fort Lauderdale at 3.20pm on QF 4370, arriving in Dallas Fort Worth at 5.30pm. (This flight is operated by American Airlines). Sydney passengers then depart Dallas fort worth at 9.15pm on QF 8, arriving in Sydney at 6.05am two days later (15.10.18 – you cross the International Date Line).
Melbourne and Brisbane passengers depart Fort Lauderdale at 7.00pm on Alaskan Airlines flight AS 1337, arriving in Los Angeles at 9.45pm.
Melbourne passengers depart Los Angeles at 10.55pm on Qantas QF 94, arriving in Melbourne at 8.50am two days later (15.10.18 – you cross the International Date Line).
Brisbane passengers depart Los Angeles at 11.20pm on Qantas flight QF 16, arriving in Brisbane at 6.10am two days later (15.10.18 – you cross the International Date Line).

Conditions for Panama Canal Fly, Cruise & Stay

Deposits and Payments - A non-refundable deposit of \$2,200 per person is payable within 3 days of booking. This deposit is not refundable should you later cancel. The balance is payable in full 12 weeks prior to departure.

Refunds and Cancellations - Cancellations after final payment will result in a refund limited to whatever we can recoup from the airline.

Airline Tickets - Please note that any changes made to airline tickets once they have been issued will likely incur high cancellation and/or reissue fees. These fees are typically set by the airline and are outside of our control.

Insurance - Adequate travel insurance is essential. We can arrange this for you if desired.

Passports - All travellers require a current passport with at least 6 months left on it at the end of the tour. Non-Australian passport holders require a re-entry visa for Australia. A visa waiver is required for travel to the United States of America for most Australian passport holders. The current cost of the visa waiver is USD \$14 per person. Please note that Australians who have travelled to Iran, Iraq, Syria or Sudan since the 1st March 2011 or Australians who are dual citizens of these countries will no longer be eligible to apply for US visa waiver and will instead need to apply for a non-immigrant visa at a US Embassy or Consulate. No other visas are required for this program if you are travelling on an Australian passport.

Basic Tour Price and Taxes - Air taxes and fuel levies are included in the basic tour price if the tour is paid in full on or before the due date on the final invoice. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to charge for any increase in air taxes and fuel levies if the tour is not paid in full by the due date.

Not Included in the Cost - All items of a personal nature such as telephone calls, drinks, excess baggage, tips, meals, (except those specified in the itinerary), travel insurance etc. and transfers not stated in the itinerary. Similarly, credit card payments (Visa/MasterCard) can only be accepted if 1% is added to the price to help defray the heavy merchant fees charged to us by the credit card companies. There is a 2% surcharge for American Express.

Health and Fitness - Macleay Valley Travel recommends that the passenger is reasonably healthy and/or fit to participate in this tour. Persons with a disability requiring special assistance must be accompanied by a companion. Macleay Valley Travel and their representatives cannot provide this service. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to accept/decline or terminate a passenger's participation in the tour under certain circumstances.

Booking through other Agents - As we keep the cost of our tours as low as possible, there is insufficient margin for us to be able to pay commission to other travel agents, so some bookings can only be accepted if the client pays the other agent's commission.
