05.03.21 Embark Majestic Princess in Sydney

Today board the Majestic Princess in Sydney. Ship departs at 4pm.

06.03.21 At sea

11.03.21 Arrive Adelaide at 7am and disembark the ship. You will be met and transferred to the Stamford Plaza or similar for a three night stay (room only).

12.03.21 Today is at leisure in Adelaide.

13.03.21 Today enjoy a full day tour to Barossa Valley.

14.03.21 Adelaide – Embarkation The Ghan

(L/D) This morning you are transferred to Adelaide train station to embark on The Ghan for your train voyage from Adelaide to Darwin. Your Gold Twin Service features include:

16.03.21 Katherine and Darwin

(B/L) Your day dawns in the tropical north. The pristine wilderness of Katherine is stirring and powerful and you will have the chance to explore it from the water or land with your choice of off train experiences. Cruise the jaw-dropping Nitmiluk Gorge, learn more about its ancient indigenous rock paintings and gain insight into the culture of the traditional owners of Nitmiluk, the Jawoyn people, or discover authentic outback life on a cattle station. As evening falls, arrive in Darwin to complete your epic Australian journey. After disembarking the train you are transferred to the hotel for a three night stay at the Hilton Darwin or similar (room only).

17.03.21 Darwin – Kakadu - Darwin

19.03.21 Darwin – Sydney/Melbourne/Brisbane

Deposits and Payments - A non-refundable deposit of \$2100 per person is payable within 3 days of booking. This deposit is not refundable should you later cancel. The balance is payable in full 14 weeks prior to departure. Passports - Australian passports are preferred, but not compulsory for this tour. Suitable photographic identification is required (e.g. drivers license). No visas are required if you are an Australia citizen.

Basic Package Price and Taxes - Air taxes and fuel levies are included in the basic package price if the tour is paid in full on or before the due date on the final invoice. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to charge for any increase in air taxes and fuel levies if the package is not paid in full by the due date.

Not Included in the Cost - All items of a personal nature such as telephone calls, drinks, excess baggage, tips, meals, (except those specified in the itinerary), travel insurance etc. and airport transfers. Similarly, credit card payments (Visa/MasterCard) can only be accepted if 1% is added to the price to help defray the heavy merchant fees charged to us by the credit card companies. There is a 2.75% surcharge for American Express.
