Itinerary for Scandinavia and the Arctic Circle Tour

Included meals are indicated as B = Breakfast, L = Lunch, D = Dinner

18.08.16 Australia - Bangkok

Depart Sydney at 10.00am on TG 476, arriving in Bangkok at 4.20pm.

Depart Brisbane at 2.00pm on TG 474, arriving in Bangkok at 8.20pm.

Depart Melbourne at 2.15pm on TG 466, arriving in Bangkok at 8.45pm.

We will be met at Bangkok Airport and transferred to the Rembrandt Hotel in Bangkok for an overnight stay.

19.08.16 Bangkok – Hua Hin

(B/L/D)

This morning we travel from Bangkok to the Royal beach resort town of Hua Hin, on the Gulf of Siam. En route we visit the unique Teakwood Palace of King Rama VI (no shorts or bare shoulders permitted for this visit).

We arrive in Hua Hin in the early afternoon and check into the Imperial Hua Hin Beach Resort, followed by some time at leisure. This evening we visit the Hua Hin market, followed by dinner at a lovely over-water restaurant.

20.08.16 Hua Hin

(B/L)

Today we have a tour to Petch Dam and Lake. We have a morning scenic drive to Petch Dam. Our first stop is at a meditation centre with a huge lady Buddha statue. Then we board a long tail boat for a two and a half hour boat tour on the lake created by the dam, viewing beautiful national park country with small scattered Karen hill-tribe settlements. We stop on a small island and inspect its interesting temple. We then do a short walking tour of the island to see its interesting statues. We next have lunch at a lovely restaurant overlooking the lake, before returning to Hua Hin.

21.08.16 Hua Hin – Bangkok

(B/L)

We have a late morning departure from the hotel and head back to Bangkok. En route we stop at Petchaburi where we inspect the mountain-top palace of King Rama IV, of 'The King & I' fame. We enjoy an included lunch in Petchaburi, and continue on to Bangkok and have a brief stop at the premises of a jewellery manufacturer. We check in to the Manhattan Hotel for day use accommodation until 8pm. The Manhattan Hotel is centrally located in the Sukhumvit shopping area.

Afterwards we transfer to the airport for our flights to Europe.

22.08.16 Bangkok – Stockholm – Helsinki, Finland

Depart Bangkok at 1.10am on TG 960, arriving into Stockholm, Sweden at 7.00am.

Upon arrival in Stockholm, we transfer to our next flight.

Depart Stockholm at 8.50am on Scandinavian Airlines flight SK 704, arriving in Helsinki at 10.45am. We are transferred to our Helsinki hotel. The rest of the day is free for you to start exploring Helsinki. Tonight, meet our tour director and fellow travellers.

- 23.08.16 Helsinki - Kuopio**
(B/D) An included orientation drive this morning features the City Hall and Parliament House, the Presidential Palace and the great Lutheran Cathedral. Then head north through unspoiled forests and lakes for an overnight in Kuopio. This evening we have an included dinner.
- 24.08.16 Kuopio - Oulu - Rovaniemi**
(B) Stop in the picturesque university town of Oulu, situated on the Bothnian Bay. Then follow the shoreline as far as Kemi before heading inland to Rovaniemi for a two night stay.
- 25.08.16 Rovaniemi**
(B) A whole day to enjoy the capital of Finnish Lapland. For hundreds of years it was famous for exporting furs and salmon to the world's rich and powerful. Unfortunately, the town was totally destroyed during World War II. The new town, which we will visit during this morning's orientation drive, was designed by Alvar Aalto in the shape of reindeer antlers. Sights include Lappia Hall, the Town Hall, the new modern church with its intriguing frescoes and the Arctic Centre. The afternoon is at leisure or you may choose to join an optional excursion to find out more about Lapland.
- 26.08.16 Rovaniemi - Sodankyla - Tankavaara - Saariselka**
(B/D) As we cross the Arctic Circle (66°31N), we will find ourselves in incomparable, unspoiled Lapland, land of reindeer. Stop at the Santa Claus Workshop with a chance to meet Father Christmas himself. North to Sodankyla, where we will see the charming Vanha Kirkko, Lapland's oldest wooden church, dating back to the 17th century. At Tankavaara, visit the Gold Museum and try panning for gold. Overnight in Saariselka, on the edge of the virgin wilderness and part of Finland's major national park. It is the largest winter sport centre in Finland and a paradise for hikers and mountain bike lovers in summer. This evening we have an included dinner.
- 27.08.16 Saariselka - Honningsvag, Norway**
(B/D) Via Ivalo we cross into Norway for a visit to the fascinating Sami Park. We then travel further into Norway and along the beautiful Porsangen Fjord to Honningsvag on the island of Mageroya, home to 4000 people and 5000 reindeer. Tonight, one of the highlights of this tour is the included drive to the North Cape, Europe's last northern outpost, on a sheer cliff rising 1000 feet from the Atlantic Ocean.
- 28.08.16 Honningsvag - Coastal Cruise - Hammerfest - Alta**
(B/D) An early start today for one of the highlights of this vacation, the fjord cruise from Honningsvag to Hammerfest. We will enjoy some of Norway's most beautiful coastal and mountain scenery as we cruise southwards. Disembark at Hammerfest and drive to Alta, situated at the mouth of the world's richest salmon river, for an overnight stay. This evening we have an included dinner.
- 29.08.16 Alta - Narvik**
(B) Continue our unforgettable journey south along the stunning shoreline of Norway. The road meanders along Kvaenangenfjord and Lyngenfjord. We are now in the Troms Province, still way beyond the Arctic Circle but with a climate mild enough to allow

very successful farming. Hear about fierce World War II battles as we approach Narvik, rebuilt after near total destruction.

30.08.16 Narvik

(B) Visit Narvik's War Museum and relive how Norwegian troops, with the help of their allies, showed the world that the Nazi war machine was not invulnerable. This afternoon and evening are at leisure.

31.08.16 Narvik - Mo

(B) This morning enter Nordland. Not far from Mo we cross the Arctic Circle again and return to a world where the sun rises and sets everyday of the year. Overnight in the little town of Mo I Rana.

01.09.16 Mo - Mosjoen - Trondheim

(B/D) On the agenda today we have a picture stop in Mosjoen, the spectacular Laksforsen Waterfall, the forests and rivers of Namdalen Valley and vistas of Trondheimfjord, the World War II hideout of the German battleship Tirpitz. This evening we have an included dinner.

02.09.16 Trondheim - Geiranger Area

(B/D) This morning we leave Norway's third largest city, also known as the "Gateway to the North" and travel via the spectacular Atlantic Road from Christiansund to Molde to reach the Geiranger area for an overnight. This evening we have an included dinner.

03.09.16 Geiranger Area

(B/D) Today is at leisure to enjoy the sites of this enchanting area on your own or join the optional Geiranger Fjord Cruise. This evening we have an included dinner.

04.09.16 Geiranger Area - Lom - Lillehammer

(B) Today travel via Dalsnibba for a stop in Lom. Take pictures of the stave churches before heading toward the famous winter sport resort, Lillehammer, host of the 1994 Winter Olympics.

05.09.16 Lillehammer - Oslo

(B) Head for Oslo via Eidsvoll. On arrival, vistas of Akerhus Castle, the 14th century fortress guarding the harbour. Our included highlights tour features the soaring City Hall, National Theatre, Parliament, Royal Palace, Broadcasting House and Gustav Vigeland's stark sculptures of people and animals in Frogner Park.

06.09.16 Oslo

(B) Today is at leisure in Oslo, for those who wish to explore more of Norway's lovely capital city.

07.09.16 Oslo - Bangkok

(B) Mid morning transfer to Oslo Airport for your flight to Bangkok, departing at 2.15pm on TG 955, arriving in Bangkok at 6.15am the next morning (08.09.16).

08.09.16 Bangkok – Australia

Melbourne passengers depart Bangkok at 8.10am on TG 461, arriving in Melbourne at 8.00pm.

Sydney and Brisbane passengers will have a free shuttle transfer to the Best Western Premier Airport Hotel for day use accommodation from 8am to 6pm.

In the afternoon Sydney passengers transfer back to the airport, departing at 7.20pm on TG 475, arriving in Sydney at 7.20am the next morning (09.09.16).

This evening Brisbane passengers transfer back to the airport, departing at 11.59pm on TG 473, arriving in Brisbane at 11.50am the next day (09.09.16).

Note: The ground operator for the European component of this tour is Cosmos.



Conditions for Macleay Valley Travel's Arctic Circle Tour

Deposits and Payments - A non-refundable deposit of \$400 per person is payable within 7 days of booking. This deposit is not refundable should you later cancel. The balance is payable 10 weeks prior to departure.

Refunds and Cancellations - Cancellations after final payment will result in a refund limited to whatever we can recoup from the airline.

Insurance - Adequate travel insurance is essential. We can arrange this for you if desired. Macleay Valley Travel offers Suresave Travel Insurance. Please note that we can only process your travel insurance when we have received full payment for the insurance and the signed Suresave Travel Insurance application form, located on the last page of the Suresave Travel Insurance information booklet. Until this time the travel insurance cannot be processed and will not be valid. Macleay Valley Travel will bear no responsibility for any consequences that may occur as a result of an incomplete insurance application.

Passports - All travellers require a current passport with at least 6 months left on it at the end of the tour. Non-Australian passport holders require a re-entry visa for Australia. No visas are required for this tour if you are travelling on an Australian passport.

Basic Tour Price and Taxes - Air taxes and fuel levies are included in the basic tour price if the tour is paid in full on or before the due date on the final invoice. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to charge for any increase in air taxes and fuel levies if the tour is not paid in full by the due date.

Breakaway Fee - All fully inclusive prices are based on group travel and any deviation from the set itinerary will incur a breakaway fee. The breakaway fee for most deviations including a post-tour extension on this tour is \$55 per person. Please inquire with our office for prices on any pre-tour extensions.

Not Included in the Cost - Travel insurance, visas and all items of a personal nature such as telephone calls, drinks, excess baggage, tips, meals (except those specified in the itinerary), etc. are not included in the cost. Similarly, credit card payments can only be accepted if 2% is added to the price to help defray the heavy merchant fees charged to us by the credit card companies. There is a 3% surcharge for Diners Club.

There are no compulsory injections required for this tour.

Booking through other Agents - As we keep the cost of our tours as low as possible, there is insufficient margin for us to be able to pay commission to other travel agents, so some bookings can only be accepted if the client pays the other agent's commission.

As such, you are assured of a consumer focused and quality assured business, ensuring professional conduct and ethical business practices. Twin Share Bookings - If you do not have a travel partner, but wish to travel at twin share rates, we will try and assign you with another traveller but this is not guaranteed. We assign passengers by their gender, on a first come, first served basis and do not assign twin share passengers according to their age, profession, interests etc. There are risks with sharing a room with a person you do not know, and Macleay Valley Travel accepts no responsibility if you are incompatible with your assigned room mate. Additionally, if you are assigned a travelling companion to share with and they cancel off the tour prior to making the final payment, then you will either be required to pay the single room supplement or we will try our best to assign you with another twin share passenger, if one is available.
