01.11.18 Australia – Singapore

Depart Brisbane at 9.10am on SQ 256, arriving in Singapore at 3.10pm.
Depart Melbourne at 10.35am on SQ 238, arriving in Singapore at 3.15pm.
Depart Sydney at 12.15pm on SQ 232, arriving in Singapore at 5.35pm.
Upon arrival we will be transferred to our airport hotel for an overnight stay.
Accommodation: Village Hotel Changi

02.11.18 Singapore - London

(B) After breakfast we are transferred to the airport for our flight to London.
Depart Singapore at 12.50pm on SQ 318, arriving in London at 7.00pm. Welcome to London! We are transferred to our London hotel for a two night stay.
Accommodation: Hilton London Metropole or similar

03.11.18 London

(B) Morning sightseeing with a local guide includes all the famous landmarks including; the Houses of Parliament and Big Ben beside the Thames River, Westminster Abbey, Whitehall's mounted horse guards, the Prime Minister's Downing Street, Piccadilly Circus, and Buckingham Palace. We visit St Paul's Cathedral, Sir Christopher Wren's masterpiece built between 1675 and 1708.

04.11.18 London – Brussels, Belgium – Amsterdam, Holland

(B/D) This morning we will meet our tour director and travelling companions and board the high-speed Eurostar Train to Brussels. Walk to the Grand Place and admire its baroque guild houses and the gothic Town Hall. Don't leave Brussels without first rubbing the statue of Everard t'Serclaes, a 14th-century hero, for good luck, and taking pictures of the tiny but world-famous statue of Manneken Pis. We continue to Amsterdam, capital of Holland, for a two night stay. Dinner this evening is included.
Accommodation: NH Amsterdam Zuid or similar

05.11.18 Amsterdam

(B) This morning we will see the main sights of the 700 year old capital with a local guide, including the original Heineken Brewery, the Rijksmuseum and more. A highlight today is a leisurely Canal Cruise, past the patrician mansions and gabled facades. We also visit a major diamond centre. Later you may wish to join an optional excursion to visit a cheese farm, a clog maker, a working windmill, and the pretty fishing village of Volendam.
Accommodation: NH Amsterdam Zuid or similar

06.11.18 Amsterdam – Heidelberg, Germany

(B/D) Pass the locale of A Bridge Too Far on the way to Germany and enjoy this afternoon's highlight, a romantic Rhine Cruise along the prettiest part of the Rhine River. Arrive in Heidelberg and take pictures of its castle. This evening enjoy an

included dinner.
Accommodation: NH Heidelberg or similar

07.11.18 Heidelberg – Black Forest – Rhine Falls, Switzerland – Lucerne

(B) This morning we stop in the Black Forest, renowned for cuckoo clocks. Hear about the art of woodcarving from local woodcarver, Adolf Herr, and enjoy a taste of the local fruit wine. Next, take pictures of the thundering Rhine Falls and continue to picturesque Lucerne for a two night stay.

08.11.18 Lucerne

(B/D) During our walking tour, admire the emotional Lion Monument, dedicated to the fallen Swiss Guards who protected the Royal House of France during the French Revolution, and cross the famous covered Chapel Bridge to the Jesuit Church. If you wish you can join optional tours either climbing Mount Pilatus by cable car, or take a cruise on the fjord-like lake. This evening enjoy an included dinner.
Accommodation: Ameron Flora or similar

09.11.18 Lucerne – Vaduz, Liechtenstein – Innsbruck – Salzburg, Austria

(B/D) A short stop in Vaduz, capital of the pocket-sized Principality of Liechtenstein. Next is Innsbruck, Austria's Olympic resort in the Tyrolean mountains. Walk through the Old Town to Emperor Maximilian's Golden Roof, and shop for crystal, for which Innsbruck is famous, before continuing to Salzburg, where a special dinner awaits us at Farmhouse Lenzenbauer.
Accommodation: Arcotel Castellani or similar

10.11.18 Salzburg – Vienna

(B) A pleasant stroll with our local guide takes us through the historic centre. Admire exquisite Mirabell Gardens, the Great Festival Hall and Residenz Square. Then, drive past the lovely Salzkammergut Lake District, made famous by the movie The Sound of Music, and along the Danube Valley to Vienna, the capital of Austria for a two night stay.
Accommodation: Hilton Vienna Danube Waterfront or similar

11.11.18 Vienna

(B) Guided sightseeing features the State Opera House, the Jewish Quarter, Heldenplatz, St Stephen's Cathedral, and a stop at Hofburg Palace. Also admire the unusual Hundertwasserhaus. To make the most of your stay you may wish to join an optional excursion to magnificent Schonbrunn Palace.
Accommodation: Hilton Vienna Danube Waterfront or similar

12.11.18 Vienna – Zagreb, Croatia – Ljubljana, Slovenia

(B/D) A scenic drive through Carinthia brings us to Zagreb, the proud capital of Croatia. Guided sightseeing features all important landmarks of the Lower Town and medieval Upper Town, such as the Parliament, Stone Gate, the Archbishop's Palace, and a visit to the majestic Cathedral. We continue to Ljubljana, the elegant capital of Slovenia for a two night stay. This evening enjoy an included dinner.

- 14.11.18 Ljubljana – Postojna – Venice, Italy**
(B) Today we enjoy an exciting visit to the spectacular Postojna Caves by mini-train. The caves were discovered in the 17th century, and opened to the public in 1819. Then, follow the Adriatic coast to romantic Venice for a two night stay.
Accommodation: Smart Holiday at Mestre or similar
- 15.11.18 Venice**
(B/D) We enter Venice in style by private boat. Highlights of our guided walking tour are St Mark's Square and Basilica, lavish Doges' Palace and the Bridge of Sighs. Also enjoy a Glassblower demonstration. The afternoon is free to explore the maze of little streets, bridges, and canals on your own or to join an exciting optional excursion to enhance your stay. This evening enjoy an included dinner.
Accommodation: Smart Holiday at Mestre or similar
- 16.11.18 Venice – Assisi**
(B/D) Through the Apennine Mountains to peaceful Assisi. Visit St Francis' Basilica, the hub of a religious order devoted to the ideals of humanity, forgiveness, simplicity, and love for all God's creatures. This evening enjoy an included dinner.
Accommodation: Grand Hotel or similar
- 17.11.18 Assisi – Amalfi Coast – Sorrento**
(B) Enjoy a comfortable drive along the Highway of the Sun past Rome to Sorrento. While driving to Positano, we will see one of Italy's most beautiful coastlines, the Amalfi Coast. Top off the experience in Positano with an included tasting of the local Limoncello Liquor. Then we travel to Sorrento for a two night stay.
Accommodation: Michelangelo or similar
- 18.11.18 Sorrento – Capri - Sorrento**
(B) Today we speed across the bay by Jetfoil to the Isle of Capri. Ride the Funicular to Capri village for a guided visit of this pretty town. There is free time to explore the little shops on the piazzetta before returning to Sorrento.
Accommodation: Michelangelo or similar
- 19.11.18 Sorrento – Pompeii – Rome**
(B) Pompeii was a Roman city both destroyed and preserved by an eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79AD. We follow our local guide past patrician homes, public baths, and commercial districts that strikingly recall day-to-day life when Rome was at the apex of her power. Then continue to Rome, the 'Eternal City' for a two night stay.
Accommodation: Crowne Plaza St Peter's or similar

- 20.11.18 Rome**
(B) Today we enjoy unique sightseeing, including inside visits to the Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel with Michelangelo's ceiling paintings and The Last Judgement. We also visit monumental St Peter's Square and Basilica to admire Michelangelo's Pieta. We continue to the Roman Forum, where Roman legions marched in triumph, and marvel at the amazing Colosseum, where gladiators once fought. For those who wish to see it all, an optional walking tour with a local guide is available to further explore famous sites like the Spanish Steps, Trevi Fountain, the Pantheon and more. Accommodation: Crowne Plaza St Peter's or similar
- 21.11.18 Rome – Florence – Tuscany**
(B/D) In Florence, the 'Cradle of the Renaissance', we enjoy a walking tour with a local guide and admire the cathedral, the Baptistery's 'Gate of Paradise' and visit sculpture-studded Signorina Square, and see Ponte Vecchio. There is time to shop for leather and gold before continuing to Montecatini, our peaceful Tuscan resort. Dinner this evening is included. Accommodation: Minerva Palace at Montecatini or similar
- 22.11.18 Tuscany – Pisa – Eze – French Riviera, France**
(B) We marvel at the Leaning Tower in Pisa before continuing on a spectacular drive along the Italian and French Rivas. Leave the highway in France, and join the Moyenne Corniche. In Eze we visit a perfume factory and hear about the history and production of perfume. Then continue to our hotel on the Cote d'Azur for a two night stay. Accommodation: Best Western Plus Massena or similar
- 23.11.18 French Riviera**
(B) Today is at leisure to enjoy this enchanting French Riviera resort at your own pace. Exciting optional excursions are available to the picturesque artist village of St Paul de Vence and to famous Monte Carlo. Accommodation: Best Western Plus Massena or similar
- 24.11.18 French Riviera – Arles – Barcelona, Spain**
(B/D) In Arles, walk to the impressive Roman Amphitheater before continuing to the Spanish border and splendid Barcelona for a two night stay. Dinner this evening is included. Accommodation: Catalonia Barcelona Plaza or similar
- 25.11.18 Barcelona**
(B) Sightseeing with a local guide features the spectacular Sagrada Familia Basilica, Gaudi's masterpiece, and a panoramic view of the city and harbour from Montjuic Hill. Also visit the Gothic Quarter. Accommodation: Catalonia Barcelona Plaza or similar
- 26.11.18 Barcelona – Madrid**
(B) Enjoy rustic Catalonian and Aragonian landscapes on our journey to Madrid, the capital of Spain since 1561. On arrival we check into our hotel for a two night stay. Accommodation: Melia Galgos or similar

(B/D) Leave the coast and travel through the Landes region to Bordeaux and enjoy an orientation tour. This evening enjoy an included dinner.


Tour Difficulty Ratings & Advice

Tour Difficulty Level 3

This tour rating typically involves a good level of physical activity, such as ascending stairs, getting into a bathtub shower, being responsible for your own luggage at airports and hotels, boarding trains quickly with your luggage, walking distances of up to 500 metres at a time over possible uneven ground and/or cobblestone streets. Walking tours of considerable distances should be expected on tours with this rating as well as some early departures.

Deposits and Payments: A non-refundable deposit of \$400 per person is payable within 7 days of booking. This deposit is not refundable should you later cancel. The balance is payable 10 weeks prior to departure.

Refunds and Cancellations: Cancellations after final payment will result in a refund limited to whatever we can recoup from the airline.

Macleay Valley Travel will bear no responsibility for any consequences that may occur as a result of an incomplete insurance application.

Passports: All travellers require a current passport with at least 6 months left on it at the end of the tour. Non-Australian passport holders require a re-entry visa for Australia. No visas are required for Australian passport holders.

Basic Tour Price and Taxes: Air taxes and fuel levies are included in the basic tour price if the tour is paid in full on or before the due date on the final invoice. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to charge for any increase in air taxes and fuel levies if the tour is not paid in full by the due date.

Not Included in the Cost: All items of a personal nature such as telephone calls, drinks, excess baggage, tips, meals, (except those specified in the itinerary), etc. Also travel insurance. Similarly, credit card payments (Visa/MasterCard) can only be accepted if 1% is added to the price to help defray the heavy merchant fees charged to us by the credit card companies. There is a 2% surcharge for American Express.

Booking through other Agents: As we keep the cost of our tours as low as possible, there is insufficient margin for us to be able to pay commission to other travel agents, so some bookings can only be accepted if the client pays the other agent's commission.

Twin Share Bookings - If you do not have a travel partner, but wish to travel at twin share rates, we will try and assign you with another traveller but this is not guaranteed. We assign passengers by their gender, on a first come, first served basis and do not assign twin share passengers according to their age, profession, interests etc. There are risks with sharing a room with a person you do not know, and Macleay Valley Travel accepts no responsibility if you are incompatible with your assigned room mate. Additionally, if you are assigned a travelling companion to share with and they cancel off the tour prior to making the final payment, then you will either be required to pay the single room supplement or we will try our best to assign you with another twin share passenger, if one is available.
