24.11.20 Australia – Doha, Qatar

Depart Sydney at 9.45pm on QR 909, arriving in Doha at 5.05am the next morning.
Depart Adelaide at 9.50pm on QR 915, arriving in Doha at 4.20am the next morning.
Depart Melbourne at 10.20pm on QR 905, arriving in Doha at 5.15am the next morning.
Depart Perth at 10.50pm on QR 901, arriving in Doha at 5.55am the next morning.

25.11.20 Doha – Amman, Jordan

All passengers depart Doha at 7.55am on QR 402, arriving in Amman at 10.10am.
Upon arrival in Amman you will be transferred to the hotel for an overnight stay.

27.11.20 Tel Aviv – Jaffa – Caesarea – Nazareth – Cana – Haifa

(B/D) Stop in Jaffa for a walk through the beautifully restored ancient port, where medieval pilgrims started their strenuous 2 day trek to Jerusalem. Then, continue your tour of the Holy Land to Caesarea, the perfect place to learn about the Roman and Crusader presence in the country. Visit the Roman Amphitheatre and the impressive Crusader Fortress and admire Herod's stadium and harbour. On to Nazareth in Galilee, to visit the contemporary Church of the Annunciation. Then Cana, site of the first miracle where Jesus changed water into wine at a wedding. To this day, many couples renew their wedding vows at this sacred place. Arrive in Haifa, a city with a long history dating back to biblical times. Dinner this evening is included.

28.11.20 Haifa – Mount of Beatitudes – Capernaum – Jordan River – Sea of Galilee

(B/D) Start your day with a visit to the golden-domed Baha'I Shrine, the world centre of Baha'I faith. Heading towards the Sea of Galilee, visit the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered his Sermon on the Mount. Then proceed to Capernaum, where Jesus recruited his first followers among the fishermen. Via the ruins of Kursi arrive at the Jordan River and visit the Baptismal Site, followed by a relaxing cruise on the Sea of Galilee. Dinner this evening is included.
Accommodation: Leonardo Plaza Haifa or similar

- 29.11.20 Haifa – Valley of Elah – Latrun – Bethlehem – Jerusalem**
(B) Drive into the ancient land of the Philistines and the Valley of Elah. Stop at the site of David’s victory over the Philistine giant, Goliath, and hear about this biblical event. Later, hear the tale of Samson and Delilah as you travel through the land of the Dan tribe to the wide Valley of Ayalon. At strategic Latrun, visit the Monastery of the Trappist Monks. Stop en route for a breathtaking panoramic view of the Holy City of Jerusalem, considered one of the oldest places in the world, with a history dating back as far as 4000 BC. Proceed to Bethlehem and see Shepherd’s Field, where the angels announced the birth of Jesus. Next visit the Church of the Nativity, which stands on the site where Jesus was born.
Accommodation: Ramada Jerusalem or similar
- 30.11.20 Jerusalem – Excursion to the Israel Museum, Yad Vashem & Mount Zion**
(B/D) Visit the Israel Museum with the Shrine of the Book and the Dead Sea Scrolls, followed by the Yad Vashem Memorial created to commemorate the six million martyrs of the Holocaust. Continue to Mount Zion and visit the Upper Room, where Jesus and his disciples had the last supper, and then the Tomb of King David. Dinner this evening is included.
Accommodation: Ramada Jerusalem or similar
- 01.12.20 Jerusalem – Excursion to the Old City**
(B) This morning, visit the Garden Tomb. After seeing a stunning panorama of the city from the revered Mount of Olives, start your guided walking tour. Via the Chapel of Dominus Flevit, designed in the shape of a tear drop to symbolise the tears of Christ, arrive at the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus prayed the night before his arrest. Nearby are the Caves of the Assumption of Mary and of the Betrayal. Follow the Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa to Golgotha and visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Erected over the site of the crucifixion, this church is shared by six Christian communities. Also see the Temple Mount and the Dome of the Rock, a splendid mosque on the holy mount. Continue to the Western Wall, the most holy shrine in the Jewish religion.
Accommodation: Ramada Jerusalem or similar
- 02.12.20 Jerusalem – Excursion to Masada & the Dead Sea**
(B/D) Drive through the Judean wilderness to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on the surface of the Earth. Enjoy the scenery as you follow the road between the salty water and majestic desert mountains. Catch glimpses of the caves of Qumran, where the precious Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Ascend by Cable car to the spectacular cliff-top Fortress of Masada and hear how 960 Jewish zealots preferred death at their hands to the indignity of surrender to overwhelming Roman forces. Around lunchtime, reach one of the comfortable Dead Sea resorts and experience the feeling of buoyancy in the heavy water. Then return to Jerusalem.
Dinner this evening is included.

- 03.12.20 Jerusalem, Israel – Allenby Bridge – Jerash, Jordan – Amman**
(B/D) A comfortable drive across the Allenby Bridge brings you to Jordan. Drive north to Jerash, which was inhabited as early as 3200 BC. Although the city was impacted by

the earthquake of 749 AD, it is the site of the best preserved Greco-Roman ruins in the Middle East. Next, arrive in Jordan's capital, Amman.

04.12.20 Amman – Wadi Rum – Petra

(B/D)

An exciting visit to Wadi Rum is on the program today. Wadi Rum is the largest wadi (ravine) in Jordan and made famous by the movie Lawrence of Arabia. Enjoy a spectacular four wheel drive adventure through the sand dunes and receive a Keffiyeh, a local headscarf. Continue to the 'Rose-Red City' of Petra, where you can relax at your hotel this evening or explore the ancient city.

Dinner this evening is included.

Accommodation: Moevenpick Nabatean Castle or similar

05.12.20 Petra

(B/D)

Guided sightseeing in Petra, a UNESCO World heritage Site and one of the New Seven Wonders of the World. Lost to the world for centuries, it is located in the biblical land of Moab. Enjoy an unforgettable experience as you walk down the Siq, the narrow gorge made famous in the movie Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade.

Stand in awe in front of the iconic and famed treasury. See spectacular temples and tombs created out of the rose-coloured sandstone and sip tea in a real Bedouin tent.


