

Itinerary for Italy, France & Spain Tour

Included meals are indicated as B = Breakfast, L = Lunch, D = Dinner

01.09.16 Australia – Hong Kong

Brisbane passengers depart at 11.10am on CX 146, arriving in Hong Kong at 8.10pm. (This flight goes via Cairns).

Sydney passengers depart at 2.15pm on CX 100, arriving in Hong Kong at 9.35pm.

Melbourne passengers depart at 2.20pm on CX 104, arriving in Hong Kong at 9.50pm.

We will be met at the airport and transferred to the Eaton Hotel for a two night stay.

02.09.16 Hong Kong

Today there will be a half day Hong Kong Island Tour.

Our first stop is Man Mo Temple, which was built in 1847 and dedicated to the gods, Man (Literature) and Mo (Martial Arts). The temple is notable for its many fine, well-polished brass and pewter incense burners. Our next stop is Victoria Peak, overlooking the west of Hong Kong Island. It is the highest peak on the island and the most enduring tourist attraction in Hong Kong. We take a ride on the city's oldest transport, the 112 year old Peak Tram. In the early colonial rule, Victoria Peak was accessible only to Hong Kong's high society while the commoners could only visit the peak by permit from the colony's governor. Today Victoria Peak is a world renowned scenic spot. Our ride on the Peak Tram ascends to Victoria Peak, which is 1805 feet above sea level. On the peak we will experience the dazzling panorama of Hong Kong Island, the harbour, Kowloon Peninsula and the hills beyond.

We also visit Aberdeen, located on the southern tip of Hong Kong Island. It is the largest satellite town with a population of about 60,000. It was a pirates den two centuries ago and later turned into a simple fishing village. In recent years, with local high rise building developments, Aberdeen has modernised and now it has become a vibrant waterfront resort for people from metropolitan Hong Kong. Despite modernization, traditional fishing life still prevails. Hundreds of junks and sampans serve as floating homes for thousands of people. They crowd in the narrow harbour, dramatically juxtaposed against the modern high rise buildings that spread up the nearby hillsides. We take a sampan ride in the harbour to truly appreciate this fascinating place, followed by a visit to a prestigious jewellery factory, where we can find famous hand-crafted jewellery.

We also stop at Stanley Market. Stanley is a coastal village on the southern side of Hong Kong Island. It is a must see place for visitors to Hong Kong. Stanley used to be a small fishing village but in recent years, a series of restaurants and pubs have been established here. Now this village is bustling with throngs of people. Stanley Market is located up the road from the harbour and is the highlight of Stanley. Over the years it's become known for its bargains, which includes silk garments, sportswear, art, Chinese costumes, souvenirs, ornaments and a host of fantastic crafts. It is one of the famous open-air markets in Hong Kong. Strolling in this street and bargaining with the shrewd vendors is something most travellers find amusing to try.

Afterwards we are returned to the hotel. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure.

03.09.16 Hong Kong

Today is at leisure in Hong Kong. We will have a 6pm late checkout from our hotel rooms. Afterwards we are transferred to the pier to enjoy an authentic Chinese

sightseeing cruise vessel and sail around the vibrant Victoria Harbour, considered to be one of the world's most impressive natural harbours. At night time the spectacular Hong Kong skyline on both sides of the harbour will fire our imagination as the dazzling neon cityscape emerges. The cruise comes to a highlight as the Symphony of Lights show brightens up the skyline with a spectacular display of laser beams bouncing off skyscrapers from both sides of the harbour every night from 8pm to 8.20pm. The synchronized 20 minute display is accompanied by music and commentary, depicting the growth of Hong Kong from a sleepy fishing village to the dynamic city it is today. During the cruise we can enjoy both the uninterrupted view of the dazzling laser show as well as an assortment of included drinks on board. After the cruise we are transferred to the airport for our flight to Rome.

04.09.16 Hong Kong - Rome

Depart Hong Kong at 12.40am on CX 293, arriving in Rome at 7.30am. We will be met at the airport and transferred to our Rome hotel. The rest of the day is free to explore this ancient capital. In the afternoon, meet our tour director.

Please note that your hotel room may not be ready for check-in until the afternoon. If you would like to be guaranteed early access into your hotel room there will be an additional charge of \$158 per person twin share or \$236 single room. Alternatively you can store your luggage at the hotel until your room becomes available.

05.09.16 Rome

(B)

Rome, the 'Eternal City', is a city steeped in history, vibrantly alive and exciting and absolutely unique! The included sightseeing with a local guide starts in St. Peter's Square, followed by a visit to the Roman Forum and the iconic Colosseum.

06.09.16 Rome - Florence - Montecatini

(B/D)

Travel to Florence, 'Cradle of the Renaissance' and city of the powerful Medici dynasty. The included walking tour with a local guide features most of the city highlights. We will see Piazza Santa Croce, beautiful Piazza Signoria, Palazzo Vecchio, Loggia dei Lanzi and the impressive Piazza del Duomo with its cathedral housing the Giotto Campanile and the magnificent East Door of the Baptistery, known as the 'Gate of Paradise.' Later, a short drive delivers us to the spa town of Montecatini for an overnight stay. Tonight enjoy an included dinner.

07.09.16 Montecatini - Parma - Venice Area

(B)

This morning we head for Parma by way of Cisa Pass. Parma is located in the Emilia-Romagna region, made famous by its ham and parmesan cheese. The included sightseeing with a local guide introduces us to the city's hidden treasures. Later, we continue into the farmland of the Po Valley for a two night stay in the Venice area.

08.09.16 Venice Area

(B/D)

Venice is more like a marvelous film set than a real-life city, with its criss-crossing canals, gondolas and water buses, arched bridges, palaces and quiet little piazzas. The included orientation starts with a boat ride to St. Mark's Square and is followed by time at leisure and a chance to watch Venetian glassblowers fashion their delicate objects as they did centuries ago. Don't miss out on the quintessential Venice experience of an optional gondola ride along the picturesque canals with a local troubadour to serenade you. Tonight enjoy an included dinner.

09.09.16 Venice Area - Verona - Milan

(B) This morning we visit Verona, which was medieval setting of Shakespeare's Romeo and Juliet. See Juliet's house and balcony and stroll around the picturesque market square. Afterwards we travel to vibrant Milan, hub of Italy's economic miracle and the capital of fashion. Enjoy a short city sightseeing tour with a local guide.

10.09.16 Milan - Italian Riviera – Monte Carlo - Cannes Area, France

(B) An early start this morning as we journey south with views of the Italian Riviera. En route we visit Monte Carlo in the principality of Monaco, the second smallest and most densely populated country in the world. Afterwards we travel to the Cannes area.

11.09.16 Cannes Area

(B) This morning we visit a perfume factory in Grasse. Later you may wish to join an optional excursion to the picturesque hilltop town of St. Paul de Vence, one of the oldest medieval towns on the French Riviera.

12.09.16 Cannes Area - Avignon - Lyon

(B/D) This morning we head to Avignon for an included visit to the magnificent Palace of the Popes (audio guide included). Then we travel onto Lyon, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, for an overnight stay. This evening enjoy an included dinner.

13.09.16 Lyon - Paris

(B) Start the day with included, guided sightseeing of Lyon, a commercial, industrial and banking powerhouse for the past 500 years. Then travel through the picturesque Burgundy vineyards and fields toward Paris, the French capital known as the 'City of Light'. Tonight don't miss the optional cabaret outing, a true Parisian spectacle!

14.09.16 Paris

(B) Our included sightseeing with a local expert takes in many of the must-see Parisian sights, such as the Eiffel Tower, Arc de Triomphe, Opera, La Sorbonne, Madeleine, the Pyramid near the Louvre, the Invalides and Champs Elysees. The remainder of the day is at leisure in Paris.

15.09.16 Paris - Amboise - Bordeaux

(B/D) Start the day by motoring south along the Loire River to Amboise for a visit with a local guide to its splendid 11th century castle that was a favourite of French kings. Continue through the Cognac Region and head towards Bordeaux on the banks of the Garonne. This evening enjoy an included dinner.

16.09.16 Bordeaux - Biarritz - Bilbao, Spain

(B/D) Leave the Landes region. Visit Biarritz, an ancient fishing village turned trendy seaside resort, before crossing the border into Spain. Overnight in the Basque capital and port town of Bilbao. Tonight enjoy an included dinner.

17.09.16 Bilbao - Pamplona - Barcelona

(B/D) Depart Bilbao this morning and stop in Pamplona, capital of the ancient Kingdom of

Navarra, before reaching Barcelona, Catalonia's lively and beautiful capital. This evening enjoy an included dinner.

18.09.16 Barcelona

(B) This morning's included sightseeing with a local guide features a drive around Montjuic to see the Olympic Stadium and a great panoramic view of the port and city. We arrive at the city centre's Plaza Catalunya and to Paseo de Gracia to marvel at Gaudi's architectural masterpieces in the Houses Batllo and Mila.

19.09.16 Barcelona - Valencia

(B) Pass through fragrant orange groves and charming seaside resorts past Tarragona and on to Valencia, known for having hosted the America's Cup in 2005. You may choose to join the optional excursion which drives along wide avenues lined with fig and palm trees and along the old quarter's narrow streets past fine gothic houses and typical patios.

20.09.16 Valencia - Cuenca - Aranjuez - Madrid

(B) Leave the coast and head inland stopping in the historical towns of Cuenca and Aranjuez, situated on the Castilian Plain. Travel on to Madrid, the Spanish capital, with time to enjoy a relaxed evening.

21.09.16 Madrid

(B/D) This morning there is an optional tour to Toledo. The splendid setting of this old walled city above the Tagus was made famous in El Greco's painting and even now it's like a great open-air museum of Spanish history and art. Later there is an included city sightseeing tour. Madrid is situated 2,180 feet above sea level and the Spaniards say Madrid is the nearest thing to heaven. This evening enjoy an included farewell dinner.

22.09.16 Madrid – Hong Kong

After breakfast this morning we are transferred to the airport for our flights home. Depart Madrid at 12.25pm on CX 320, arriving in Hong Kong at 7.05am the next morning 23.09.16).

23.09.16 Hong Kong - Australia

Sydney passengers depart Hong Kong at 9.00am on CX 139, arriving in Sydney at 8.00pm.

Melbourne passengers depart Hong Kong at 10.35am on CX 163, arriving in Melbourne at 9.50pm.

Brisbane passengers depart Hong Kong at 12.50pm on CX 157, arriving in Brisbane at 11.25pm.

Deposits and Payments - A non-refundable deposit of \$400 per person is payable within 7 days of booking. This deposit is not refundable should you later cancel. The balance is payable in full 10 weeks prior to departure.

Refunds and Cancellations - Cancellations after final payment will result in a refund limited to whatever we can recoup from the airline.

Insurance - Adequate travel insurance is essential. We can arrange this for you if desired. Macleay Valley Travel offers Suresave Travel Insurance. Please note that we can only process your travel insurance when we have received full payment for the insurance and the signed Suresave Travel Insurance application form, located on the last page of the Suresave Travel Insurance information booklet. Until this time the travel insurance cannot be processed and will not be valid. Macleay Valley Travel will bear no responsibility for any consequences that may occur as a result of an incomplete insurance application.

Passports - All travellers require a current passport with at least 6 months left on it at the end of the tour. Non-Australian passport holders require a re-entry visa for Australia. Visas are not required if travelling on an Australian passport.

Basic Tour Price and Taxes - Air taxes and fuel levies are included in the basic tour price if the tour is paid in full on or before the due date on the final invoice. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to charge for any increase in air taxes and fuel levies if the tour is not paid in full by the due date.

Breakaway Fee - All fully inclusive prices are based on group travel and any deviation from the set itinerary will incur a breakaway fee. The breakaway fee for most deviations including a post-tour extension on this tour is \$105 per person. Please inquire with our office for prices on any pre-tour extensions.

Not Included in the Cost - Travel Insurance, visas and all items of a personal nature such as telephone calls, drinks, excess baggage, tips, meals, (except those specified in the itinerary) etc are not included in the cost. Similarly, credit card payments can only be accepted if 2% is added to the price to help defray the heavy merchant fees charged to us by the credit card companies. There is a 3% surcharge for Diners Club.

Booking through other Agents - As we keep the cost of our tours as low as possible, there is insufficient margin for us to be able to pay commission to other travel agents, so some bookings can only be accepted if the client pays the other agent's commission.

Accreditation - Macleay Valley Travel is a fully accredited travel agency under the AFTA (Australian Federation of Travel Agents) ATAS - AFTA Travel Accreditation Scheme. As such, you are assured of a consumer focused and quality assured business, ensuring professional conduct and ethical business practices. We are happy for any prospective traveller with us to check us out with your local Consumer Affairs (Fair Trading) department.

Twin Share Bookings - If you do not have a travel partner, but wish to travel at twin share rates, we will try and assign you with another traveller but this is not guaranteed. We assign passengers by their gender, on a first come, first served basis and do not assign twin share passengers according to their age, profession, interests etc. There are risks with sharing a room with a person you do not know, and Macleay Valley Travel accepts no responsibility if you are incompatible with your assigned room mate. Additionally, if you are assigned a travelling companion to share with and they cancel off the tour prior to making the final payment, then you will either be required to pay the single room supplement or we will try our best to assign you with another twin share passenger, if one is available.
