### **24.05.20 Australia – Hong Kong**

Depart Melbourne at 9.40am on Qantas flight QF 29, arriving in Hong Kong at 5.20pm.  
Depart Brisbane at 10.10am on Qantas flight QF 96, arriving in Hong Kong at 5.25pm.  
Depart Sydney at 10.20am on Qantas flight QF 127, arriving in Hong Kong at 6.00pm.  
Upon arrival we are met and transferred to the hotel.

### **25.05.20 Hong Kong**

**(B/D)**

This morning we will have a half day Hong Kong Island Tour.

Our first stop is Man Mo Temple, which was built in 1847 and dedicated to the gods, Man (Literature) and Mo (Martial Arts). The temple is notable for its many fine, well-polished brass and pewter incense burners. We take a ride on the city's oldest transport, the 112 year old Peak Tram, which ascends to Victoria Peak at 1805 feet above sea level. Victoria Peak overlooks the west of Hong Kong Island and is the highest peak on the island and the most enduring tourist attraction in Hong Kong. On the peak we will experience the dazzling panorama of Hong Kong Island, the harbour, Kowloon Peninsula and the hills beyond.

We also visit Aberdeen, located on the southern tip of Hong Kong Island. It is the largest satellite town with a population of about 60,000. It was a pirates den two centuries ago and later turned into a simple fishing village. In recent years, with local high rise building developments, Aberdeen has modernised and now it has become a vibrant waterfront resort for people from metropolitan Hong Kong. Despite modernization, traditional fishing life still prevails. Hundreds of junks and sampans serve as floating homes for thousands of people. They crowd in the narrow harbour, dramatically juxtaposed against the modern high rise buildings that spread up the nearby hillsides. We take a sampan ride in the harbour to truly appreciate this fascinating place, followed by a visit to a jewellery factory.

We also stop at Stanley Market. Stanley is a coastal village on the southern side of Hong Kong Island and the market is located up the road from the harbour and is the highlight of Stanley. Over the years it's become known for its bargains, which includes silk garments, sportswear, art, Chinese costumes, souvenirs, ornaments and a host of fantastic crafts. Afterwards we are returned to the hotel for some free time. Our hotel rooms will be available until 6pm.

This evening we check out of the hotel and transfer to the pier for a cruise onboard the MV Rainbow Star to Lamma Island, which is located on the south west side of Hong Kong Island. Here we will enjoy a seafood dinner with award winning dishes at the Rainbow Seafood Restaurant. Visitors from all over the world flock to the island to enjoy fresh seafood at a plethora of terraced restaurants raised on stilts above the bay. After dinner we cruise back to the mainland while enjoying the world class multimedia light and sound show 'A Symphony of Lights'. This show has been awarded the world's largest permanent light and sound show by Guinness World Records. After disembarking the ship we are transferred to the airport for our flights to Russia.

### **26.05.20 Hong Kong – Helsinki - Moscow, Russia**

**(D)**

Depart Hong Kong at 00.25am on Finnair flight AY 100, arriving in Helsinki at 6.00am. Then depart Helsinki at 7.30am on flight AY 711, arriving in Moscow at 9.15am. Upon arrival we are met and transferred to our ship, the MS Nikolay Chernishevsky. Later this

afternoon there will be an information briefing. Dinner is onboard the ship, followed by live music in the bar for this evenings entertainment.

The MS Nikolay Chernishevsky is a four deck vessel that is 125 metres long and travels at a speed of up to 26 KMPH. The ship was built in 1981, and had a major refurbishment in 2018. The ship has a passenger capacity of 218 and is equipped with two restaurants, two bars, conference hall, solarium, sauna, medical room, souvenir store and ironing room. All cabins are outside with scenic windows and equipped with private facilities, heating/ventilation and electricity supply.

### **27.05.20 Moscow**

**(B/L/D)**

Moscow is Russia's largest city, as well as it's political and economic capital. Through bribes, diplomacy and coercion, Moscow overcame its two rival principalities to become Russia's first city. Moscow's role was briefly challenged when Tsar Peter the Great moved the capital to his new city Saint Petersburg, on the shores of the Baltic Sea. Today we have a bus city tour including Leningradskaya Avenue, Tverskaya Street, Theatralny Passage, Lubyanka, K.G.B. Building and Manezh Square. We also have some free time in Red Square (if open). See GUM department store building, Historical Museum, Resurrection Gate, Kazan Church, Intercession Cathedral and the Cathedral of Christ the Saviour. Lunch is at a restaurant in the city.

This afternoon we will go inside the Kremlin, the ancient castle built to withstand the Mongol hordes. Throughout history, the Kremlin has been the centre of political power in Russia and it remains a symbolic political centre even today. It is the official site of the inauguration ceremony of the Russian President. The Kremlin is a living museum of Russia's history. We will see the most interesting places in the Kremlin as we follow our professional guide in the steps of some of the world's greatest leaders and its most terrible dictators. See the Palace of Congresses, Senate Square, Arsenal & Senate buildings, residence of the President of the Russian Federation, Tsar Bell and Tsar Cannon. Also see Assumption Cathedral and Annunciation Cathedral, with a visit to one of them.

Afterwards we are returned to the ship (unless doing optional tours).

This evening you may wish to take part in some of the optional excursions on offer which may include the National folk show 'Kostroma' or Moscow by Night & Metro.

Accommodation: On board

### **28.05.20 Moscow**

**(B/L/D)**

Today is at leisure to explore Moscow or relax on the ship. The optional excursions available should include the New Maidens Convent and the Cathedral of Christ the Saviour.

Later this afternoon all passengers will return to the ship for our departure to Uglich. Tonight there will be a presentation of the crew and staff with the Captain's Welcome Cocktail Party. The dress code for this evening is Smart Casual.

Dinner is onboard the ship followed by live music in the bar.

Accommodation: On board

### **29.05.20 Uglich**

**(B/L/D)**

This morning is at leisure aboard the ship while we continue cruising to Uglich.

Uglich is a small town located on the Volga River. It is most famous for the tragic events that took place in 1591, when the 10 year old Prince Dimitry, the last heir to the throne of the ancient Ruyrik Dynasty, was killed here. Historians now agree that he was killed by Boris Godunov, adviser to Dimitry, who wanted the throne to himself. Dimitry's death plunged Russia into decades of political turmoil known as the Time of Trouble.

In the afternoon we will discover the town on a walking tour with a visit to the territory of

the Kremlin, Transfiguration Cathedral and the church of Saint Dimitry on the Blood. We then return to the ship and depart for Yaroslavl.

Throughout our time onboard the ship, we will experience live music concerts, a Russian language course, Russian song lessons, dancing music in bars nightly and the Captain's bridge tour.

**30.05.20 Yaroslavl**

**(B/L/D)**

By today's standards Yaroslavl is small, but its place in Russia's history and culture can not be underestimated. Before it was annihilated by the Mongols it was Russia's largest city. It was the economic, political, cultural and scientific centre. It was rebuilt shortly after but was once again burnt to the ground. While the Mongols had been preoccupied with Yaroslavl, Moscow was able to harness enough power to overthrow the 'Mongol yoke.' This morning we will explore this town on the Volga River by bus with stops in Nikolas Wonderworker, Governor's House Art Gallery and church of the Prophet Elijah (outside visit). There will also be some free time to explore the local market. This afternoon the ship departs for Goritsy.

Accommodation: On board

**31.05.20 Goritsy**

**(B/L/D)**

Goritsy is famous for the Kirillo-Belozersky Monastery (1397). This monastery's strong walls and bastions were used by some nobles as a safe house during the Time of Trouble. The Polish Armies stormed it, but never succeeded in capturing it. Unfortunately, the monastery was not successful in repelling the attacks of other invaders four centuries later. The Bolsheviks closed the monastery in the early 20th century and sent its monks to the prison camps. On our walking tour around the small town we will go inside the local Monastery of Saint Cyril on the White Lake, an exceptional museum of icons.

This afternoon the ship departs for Kizhi.

Accommodation: On board

**01.06.20 Kizhi**

**(B/L/D)**

Kizhi is the name of a unique island located on Lake Onega. In the centre of the island stands the amazing Transfiguration Church. This wooden church and its 22 domes are said to be built without a single nail. In fact, originally, the Transfiguration Church was located in another place. The Bolsheviks, who had little, if no, respect for religion, had some respect for its architectural value. So they decided to move this unique church as far from the major cities and people as possible, to distant Kizhi Island. We will devote this afternoon on the island to the open-air museum of wooden architecture. This evening the ship departs for Mandrogi.

Accommodation: On board

**02.06.20 Mandrogi**

**(B/L/D)**

This morning there is a round table discussion where the ship guides are glad to answer any questions you may have about Russian life. Afterwards we visit Mandrogi, which is the name of a small village that has no architectural wonders, giant castles or churches. You will however discover the unique style and architecture of the northern tribes that have occupied these lands for centuries.

Here among the beautiful landscapes of this peaceful place we will have a picnic ashore with a famous Russian shashlik (meat kebab) made on the grill. We will have free time to stroll around the town to visit typical wooden houses, numerous craft exhibitions, Russian pancake and pie houses and possibly buy some souvenirs, before returning to the ship. In

the afternoon the ship departs for St Petersburg.

This evening we have the Captain's Dinner. Dress code is Smart Casual for this occasion. Afterwards we have a talent show, performed by the guests on board. This is followed by music and dancing in the bar.

Accommodation: On board

**03.06.20 St Petersburg**

**(B/L/D)**

St Petersburg is Russia's cultural and historical treasure and one of the world's most beautiful cities. It is known as the 'Venice of the North', thanks to its numerous canals and hundreds of bridges. It can rightly be called a living museum as many of its buildings are a part of Russia's history.

This morning we have a bus city sightseeing tour of St Petersburg. We drive past Smolny Convent, Tavrishesky Palace, Summer Garden, Palace Embankment, Winter Palace, Buildings of Stock Exchange and Nevsky Prospect. We then have a walking tour of St Peter and Paul's Fortress, followed by lunch in a city restaurant.

In the afternoon we have a walking tour of magnificent Peterhof (lower park only). See the Grand Cascade with the Samson Fountain, Greenhouse, Roman Fountains, The Chessboard, Trick Fountains (Oaklet, Umbrella, Bench), Palace Monplezire and a view of the Gulf of Finland. Afterwards we return to the ship

Tonight you may like to take part in an optional excursion to see St Petersburg by Night.

Accommodation: On board

**04.06.20 St Petersburg**

**(B/L/D)**

This morning we have an inside visit to the Winter Palace, which is home to the Hermitage Museum, the largest collection of Russian art in the world. The Hermitage originally started as the private art collection of Catherine The Great. The art works are displayed in numerous halls, many of which are works of art in themselves.

Following this we return to ship and have lunch on board. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure. There should be a 'Rivers & Canals' optional tour available, and this evening there may be an optional excursion to see the ballet.

**05.06.20 St Petersburg**

**(B/L/D)**

Today is at leisure for you to explore St Petersburg at your own pace. You may wish to take the optional excursion on offer to Pushkin (Catherine Palace and Park).

**06.06.20 St Petersburg – Helsinki, Finland**

**(B)**

After breakfast we disembark the ship and are transferred to the railway station to board our train to Helsinki (second class ticket). Upon arrival in Helsinki we are met and transferred to our hotel for a three night stay. The rest of the day is at leisure.

Accommodation: Original Sokos Hotel Presidentti

**07.06.20 Helsinki**

**(B/L)**

Today we have a guided sightseeing tour of Helsinki and Old Porvoo. The tour includes an outside visit of Temppeliaukio, the famous "Rock Church" which has been carved into solid rock, Sibelius Park and a walk to view the Sibelius Monument. We also see the Olympic Stadium, built for the 1952 Olympic Games, as well as the modern Opera House, the Alvar Aalto designed Finlandia Hall, the National Museum, the Market Square and harbour, overlooked by the red brick onion-domed Uspenski Russian Orthodox cathedral. Following this we have some time to walk around Senate Square and the green-domed

Lutheran Cathedral, which is the symbol of the city.

Afterwards we travel out of Helsinki and less than an hour later arrive at the picturesque town of Porvoo, the second oldest town in Finland.

Stroll through the medieval Old Quarter, along old cobbled streets of historic painted wooden houses, cafes and antique stores. The town is famous for its ochre-painted shore houses along the riverside. The 13th century cathedral is the town's major historic landmark. Whilst in Porvoo Old Town, we have lunch at a local restaurant. Afterwards we are returned to our hotel, with the remainder of the day at leisure.

**08.06.20 Tallinn Day Excursion**

**(B)** Today we have an excursion to Tallinn, the medieval capital of Estonia. We depart from the hotel by bus for a short transfer to the pier. We then board the fast boat for a 2 hour trip across the Baltic Sea to Tallinn. At Tallinn pier, we meet our local guide and are taken on a short panoramic tour around historic Tallinn by coach. We pass by Kadriorg Palace and the Song Festival Grounds, and learn from the guide a little about modern life in Tallinn. We disembark for a walking tour of the Old Town and experience the history as we walk through the tight and winding medieval streets up to the top of Toompea Hill, which has views across the red roofs of the old buildings to the sea beyond. The walking tour also passes the Parliament Building, Alexander Nevsky Cathedral, the Dome Church and ends at the Town Hall Square. This is followed by some free time to shop or relax in a street side café. We then transfer back to the ferry terminal to catch the ferry back to Helsinki. Upon arrival in Helsinki we are transferred back to the hotel.

**09.06.20 Helsinki – Singapore**

**(B)** Today is at leisure in Helsinki. We have a 6pm late checkout from our hotel rooms. Later we are transferred to the airport for our flight to Singapore. Depart Helsinki at 11.55pm on Finnair flight AY 131, arriving in Singapore at 4.30pm the next day (10.06.20).

**10.06.20 Singapore**

Upon arrival in Singapore, we are transferred to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Accommodation: Oasia Hotel Downtown

**11.06.20 Singapore - Australia**

**(B)** This morning is at leisure in Singapore. We have a 12 noon check out from the hotel. At 12.30pm we are collected for a Gardens by the Bay Tour. Discover a world of wonders at this award winning attraction. It features more than 500,000 plants from over 2,200 species. Replicating the cool and dry Mediterranean climate, the Flower Dome features nine different gardens from six continents:

- Baobabs & Bottle Trees
- Succulent Garden
- Australian Garden
- South African Garden
- South American Garden
- Californian Garden
- Mediterranean Garden
- Olive Grove
- Changing Flower Field Display

At the Cloud Forest, explore the highlands amidst orchids, pitcher plants and ferns from

the cool, moist Tropical Montane region. Featuring one of the world's tallest indoor waterfalls at 35 metres as well as seven discovery zones; Lost World, Cloud Walk, Tree-top Walk, Crystal Mountain, Earth Check, +5 Degrees, The Secret Garden.

Our tour includes admission to two conservatories, but excludes admission to the OCBC Skywalk and Garden Cruiser.

Afterwards we are transferred to the airport for our flights home.

Sydney passengers depart Singapore at 7.30pm on Qantas flight QF 2, arriving in Sydney at 5.10am the next morning (12.06.20).

Melbourne passengers depart Singapore at 8.15pm on Qantas flight QF 36, arriving in Melbourne at 5.35am the next morning (12.06.20).

Brisbane passengers depart Singapore at 8.30pm on Qantas flight QF 52, arriving in Brisbane at 6.05am the next morning (12.06.20).







**Deposits and Payments** - A non-refundable deposit of \$600 per person is payable within 7 days of booking. This deposit is not refundable should you later cancel. The balance is payable in full 11 weeks prior to departure. Macleay Valley Travel often has to adhere to strict payment deadlines and your booking on the tour may be cancelled if final payment is not received by the due date, with no refund applicable.

**Refunds and Cancellations** - Cancellations after final payment will result in a refund limited to whatever we can recoup from the airline.

**Airline Tickets** - Please note that any changes made to airline tickets once they have been issued will likely incur high cancellation and/or reissue fees. These fees are typically set by the airline and are outside of our control.

**Passports** - All travellers require a current passport with at least 6 months left on it at the end of the tour. Non-Australian passport holders require a re-entry visa for Australia. Visas are required for Russia and the current cost is \$135 plus \$30 processing. Please note that this cost is subject to any changes made by the Russian Consulate. No other visas are required on this tour if you are travelling on an Australian passport.

**Basic Tour Price and Taxes** - Air taxes and fuel levies are included in the basic tour price if the tour is paid in full on or before the due date on the final invoice. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to charge for any increase in air taxes and fuel levies if the tour is not paid in full by the due date.

**Breakaway Fee** - All fully inclusive prices are based on group travel and any deviation from the set itinerary will incur a breakaway fee.
