## **Itinerary for Spain, Portugal and Morocco Tour**

Included meals are indicated as B = Breakfast, L = Lunch, D = Dinner

### **09.05.24 Australia - Dubai**

Depart Brisbane at 2.50am on EK 431, arriving in Dubai at 11.00am.  
Depart Melbourne at 5.15am on EK 409, arriving in Dubai at 1.10pm.  
Depart Sydney at 6.00am on EK 415, arriving in Dubai at 2.10pm.  
All passengers are transferred to the Dubai hotel for a two night stay.  
Accommodation: Hyatt Place Dubai or similar

### **10.05.24 Dubai (B)**

After an included breakfast, we commence a half day city tour of modern Dubai. First we drive to Dubai Palm Jumeirah area and have a photo-stop of Blue Water Island. We then have an included one way monorail ride to the Palm Jumeirah. We continue for photo-stops at the iconic Burj Al Arab Hotel, The Point at the Palm and Dubai of the Future Museum. Afterwards we visit a showroom to see Lewan carpet art. Following this we are returned to the hotel with the remainder of the afternoon at leisure.

For those who wish there is an optional Dubai Desert Safari with Arabian BBQ dinner. The estimated price is \$50 USD per person, and can be paid to the guide on the day. Please note this activity can be quite rough and is not suitable for everyone.

### **11.05.24 Dubai – Madrid (D)**

We have an early morning transfer to the airport for our flight to Spain. Depart Dubai at 7.40am on EK 141, arriving in Madrid at 1.25pm. Upon arrival in Madrid we are transferred to our hotel for a two night stay. Tonight we meet our tour director during an included dinner.  
Accommodation: Hotel Praga or similar

### **12.05.24 Madrid (B)**

Spaniards say the Spanish capital, situated 2,180 feet above sea level is the nearest thing to Heaven. Make the most of today on our included guided sightseeing tour, a full panoramic drive by way of the Calle Alcalá, Parliament Square and a picture stop outside the Royal Palace.

The remainder of the day is at leisure. For those who wish there is an optional tour to Toledo. The splendid setting of this old walled city above the Tagus was made famous in El Greco's painting, and even now it's like a great open-air museum of Spanish history and art.

Accommodation: Hotel Praga or similar

### **13.05.24 Madrid - Avila - Salamanca - Coimbra, Portugal (B/D)**

We head west this morning for a visit to ancient fortified Avila with its many towers, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We continue to Salamanca and spend some time wandering around Plaza Mayor, the grandest square in Spain. Across the border to Guarda, one of the most important strongholds in a set of fortifications which defended the Portuguese against Castile and Leon during the Middle Ages. From

here we descend to the valleys of the Serra da Estrela to Coimbra for an overnight stay. This evening we have an included dinner.

Accommodation: Hotel Dom Luis or similar

**14.05.24 Coimbra - Fatima – Obidos - Lisbon**

**(B)**

Enjoy an included orientation tour of Coimbra, celebrated for its beauty and ancient university. Later we travel southwards to visit the Sanctuary of Fatima, one of Europe's most celebrated Marian shrines. We continue to fortified Obidos, known as one of the most picturesque towns in Portugal, before reaching Lisbon for a two night stay.

Accommodation: Roma Hotel or similar

**15.05.24 Lisbon**

**(B)**

Henry the Navigator made Lisbon the 15th century "Mistress of the Seas." On the included tour, see his monument, the Belem Tower, the Moorish Citadel and the impressive Commerce Square. Spend the afternoon at leisure in the Alfama's tile decorated streets, or take an optional excursion to the Portuguese Riviera.

Accommodation: Roma Hotel or similar

**16.05.24 Lisbon - Seville, Spain**

**(B/D)**

From the rolling plains of the Alentejo with its woodlands of cork and eucalyptus trees, we head south all the way to the brilliant light of Andalucia. Admire its neat white painted villages and sun drenched plantations of olives, figs and almonds, while travelling to magnificent Seville. This evening we have an included dinner.

Accommodation: Hotel Don Paco or similar

**17.05.24 Seville**

**(B)**

Enjoy an included sightseeing tour of this vibrant city. Walk in the city centre, see some of the main highlights and spend time to admire the impressive Plaza d'España. Admire the banks of tiles representing the provinces of Spain. A frequent ritual for Spanish visitors is to look for the space dedicated to their province to take photographs. This afternoon is at leisure.

**18.05.24 Seville - Ferry to Morocco - Rabat**

**(B/D)**

Today we drive through Spain's scenic sherry wine region and head south to the coast. Here we embark on the ferry and cruise across the Strait of Gibraltar to Morocco on the continent of Africa. Next we travel along what was once northern Africa's infamous Barbary Coast. Then we continue our drive south to Rabat, one of Morocco's imperial cities. Rabat is a cultural city deep-rooted in history, with many masterpieces decorating its streets and squares. The city is also a modern eco-responsible capital with its green spaces and beautiful parks. This evening enjoy an included dinner.

Accommodation: Hotel Mercure Rabat Sheherazade or similar

**19.05.24 Rabat - Casablanca - Marrakesh**

**(B/D)**

Today starts with an included guided city sightseeing tour of the country's lively capital, including a visit to Chellah Gardens and Casbah des Oudaias. Later we reach

Morocco's western-most city, Casablanca. Enjoy an orientation drive in this modern city and see the illustrious Hassan II Mosque, perched dramatically on a platform over the Atlantic Ocean. It is one of the largest mosques in the world and its minaret soars 689 feet into the sky and part of the mosque's floor is made of glass so worshippers can kneel directly over the ocean's waters.

We continue onto the red oasis city of Marrakesh. Between tradition and modernity, Marrakesh is a city of unequalled sensations. The Jemaa El-Fna Square, the souks with their shimmering colours and oriental aromas makes Marrakesh a city of contrasts.

This evening we enjoy a feast of local specialities and wine on our included dinner, as well as a folklore show with music, belly dancing and more.

**20.05.24 Marrakesh**

**(B/D)**

The highlight of this morning is the included city sightseeing that will make us feel like we've been whisked back in time. Founded in the 9th century, Marrakesh remains a tapestry of ramparts, mosques, palaces, gardens and vibrant public squares and souks (markets), where buying and selling creates an entertaining atmosphere. We also visit Bahia Palace and Majorelle Gardens.

This evening we have an included dinner.

Accommodation: Zalagh Kasbah Hotel & Spa or similar

**21.05.24 Marrakesh - Fez**

**(B/D)**

Today we travel from Marrakesh to Fez, enjoying glimpses of North African village life reminiscent of Beau Geste. This evening enjoy an included dinner.

**22.05.24 Fez**

**(B)**

Ancient Fez is a city of outstanding scenic beauty. This morning we have an included sightseeing tour of the Medina, to discover the maze of narrow streets through the colourful bazaars and the exotic atmosphere. The madrasas, fondouks, palaces, residences, mosques and fountains dating back to the 13<sup>th</sup> century are now UNESCO World Heritage sites.

The afternoon is at leisure to explore at your own pace.

**23.05.24 Fez - Ferry to Spain – Costa del Sol - Mijas**

**(B/D)**

This morning we have an early departure north for the ferry back to mainland Spain to the Costa del Sol (Coast of the Sun). We overnight in Mijas.

This evening enjoy an included dinner.

**24.05.24 Mijas - Granada, Spain**

**(B/D)**

This morning we drive along the Costa del Sol and head to Granada, in the heart of Andalusia. We have an included guided visit of the Alhambra, a lavish palace and fortress complex built by Moorish kings. Marvel at its architectural beauty and magnificent gardens with construction dating back to 889 A.D.

Please note that the entrance to Nasrid Palace is not guaranteed, as it depends on the local authorities. This evening enjoy an included dinner.

**25.05.24 Granada - Madrid**

**(B)** Today we travel north to Madrid through the very heart of La Mancha region, famed for its castle, windmills and wine. We have an overnight stay in Madrid.

**26.05.24 Madrid - Barcelona**

**(B)** We transfer to Madrid train station to take a high speed train to Barcelona. Upon arrival in Barcelona we transfer to our hotel for a two night stay.

Our time in Barcelona is at leisure to do as much or as little as you choose.

**28.05.24 Barcelona – Dubai**

Today is at leisure in Barcelona. We check out of the hotel at the standard check out time. After this we can store our luggage in the reception area of the hotel until our afternoon transfer to the airport for our flights home.  
Depart Barcelona at 8.40pm on flight EK 188, arriving in Dubai at 5.35am the next morning (29.05.24).

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### Tour Difficulty Level 3

This tour rating typically involves a good level of physical activity, such as ascending stairs, getting into a bathtub shower, being responsible for your own luggage at airports and hotels, walking distances of approximately 500 metres and over at a time, over possible uneven ground and/or cobblestone streets. Walking tours of considerable distances should be expected on tours with this rating as well as early departures. This tour covers three countries within Europe & Africa and has a significant amount of time spent on the coach.

**Deposits and Payments** - A non-refundable deposit of \$400 per person is payable within 7 days of booking. This deposit is not refundable should you later cancel. The balance is payable in full 10 weeks prior to departure. Macleay Valley Travel has to adhere to strict payment deadlines and your booking on the tour may be cancelled if final payment is not received by the due date, with no refund applicable.

**Refunds and Cancellations** - Cancellations after final payment will result in a refund limited to whatever we can recoup from the airline. Any refund for a cancelled booking will not be paid until the airline provides the refund to Macleay Valley Travel.

**Limitation of Liability concerning Covid-19** - It is possible that there may be outbreak(s) of Covid-19 during this tour.

Whilst we take necessary safety precautions, Macleay Valley Travel cannot be held responsible for any quarantines or other associated costs brought about by quarantines, border closures and/or travel delays. **Insurance** - Adequate travel insurance that includes medical coverage for Covid-19 is required. Please contact your preferred travel insurance provider. **Airline Tickets** - Please note that any changes made to airline tickets once they have been issued will likely incur high cancellation and/or reissue fees. These fees are typically set by the airline and are outside of our control.

**Passports** - All travellers require a current passport with at least 6 months left on it at the end of the tour. Non-Australian passport holders require a re-entry visa for Australia. From November 2023, Australian citizens travelling to the EU will require an ETIAS (European Travel Information and Authorisation System) for stays of up to 90 days. This is otherwise known as a European visa waiver. The expected cost for this is 7-10 Euros per person, payable by credit card.

**Ground Operator** - Our primary operator for this tour is Cosmos. They will be in touch closer to the departure date to obtain your acceptance to their own terms and conditions. These conditions must be accepted to participate on the tour, and are in addition to Macleay Valley Travel's terms and conditions.

**Basic Tour Price and Taxes** - Air taxes and fuel levies are included in the basic tour price if the tour is paid in full on or before the due date on the final invoice. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to charge for any increase in air taxes and fuel levies if the tour is not paid in full by the due date.

**Not Included in the Cost** - All items of a personal nature such as telephone calls, drinks, excess baggage, tips, meals, (except those specified in the itinerary), etc. Also travel insurance and departure taxes.
