Itinerary for Spain, Portugal and Morocco Tour

04.10.17 Australia - Dubai

Depart Brisbane at 9.00pm on EK 435, arriving in Dubai at 5.20am the next morning (05.10.17).

Depart Sydney at 9.45pm on EK 413, arriving in Dubai at 5.15am the next morning (05.10.17).

Depart Perth at 10.10pm on EK 421, arriving in Dubai at 5.20am the next morning (05.10.17).

Depart Melbourne at 10.25pm on EK 407, arriving in Dubai at 5.30am the next morning (05.10.17).

05.10.17 Dubai - Madrid

(D) Transfer to the next flight. All passengers depart Dubai at 7.35am on EK 141, arriving in Madrid, Spain at 1.25pm. We are transferred to our hotel. The remainder of the day is at leisure to start exploring lively Madrid. Tonight, meet our tour director at an included dinner.

06.10.17 Madrid

(B) Spaniards say the Spanish capital, situated 2,180 feet above sea level, is the nearest thing to heaven. Our sightseeing tour includes a panoramic drive by way of the Avenida Mayor, Puerta del Sol, Parliament Square and a picture stop outside the Royal Palace.

07.10.17 Madrid - Avila - Salamanca - Coimbra, Portugal

(B/D) Head west for a visit to fortified Avila with its many towers. We continue to Salamanca, just six miles from the spot where Wellington routed Napoleon's army in 1812. Make sure you spend some time wandering around Plaza Mayor, the grandest square in Spain. Across the frontier to Guarda, the highest town in Portugal. From here, descend to the valleys of the Serra da Estrela to Coimbra for an overnight stay. This evening enjoy an included dinner.

08.10.17 Coimbra - Fatima - Obidos - Lisbon

(B) This morning enjoy an orientation tour of Coimbra, celebrated for its beauty and ancient university. Later we travel southwards to visit the Sanctuary of Fatima, one of Europe's most celebrated Marian shrines. We continue to fortified Obidos, known as one of the most picturesque towns in Portugal, before reaching Lisbon for a two night stay.

09.10.17 Lisbon

(B) Henry the Navigator made Lisbon the 15th century "Mistress of the Seas." On the included tour, see his monument, the Belem Tower, the Moorish Citadel and the impressive Black Horse Square. Spend the afternoon in the Alfama's tile decorated streets, or take an optional excursion to coastal Estoril and Cascais.

10.10.17 Lisbon - Seville, Spain

(B/D) From the rolling plains of the Alentejo with its woodlands of cork and eucalyptus trees, head southwards all the way to the brilliant light of Andalucia. Admire its neat white painted villages and sun drenched plantations of olives, figs and almonds, while travelling to magnificent Seville. This evening enjoy an included dinner.

11.10.17 Seville

(B) This morning we enjoy an included sightseeing tour of the city's main highlights, such as the cathedral, Alcazar and Plaza d'Espana. The afternoon is at leisure.

12.10.17 Seville - Ferry to Morocco - Rabat

(B/D) An interesting drive today starts with views of the sherry wine region before reaching the coast for embarkation on the ferry to Morocco. Cruise across the Strait of Gibraltar to Morocco on the continent of Africa. Next we travel along what was once northern Africa's infamous Barbary Coast. Then continue our drive south to Rabat, one of Morocco's imperial cities. This evening enjoy an included dinner.

13.10.17 Rabat - Casablanca - Marrakesh

(B/D) Today starts with an included guided city sightseeing tour of the country's lively capital, including a visit to Chellah Gardens and Casbah des Oudaias. Later we reach Morocco's western-most city, Casablanca. Enjoy an orientation drive in this modern city and see the illustrious Hassan II Mosque, perched dramatically on a platform over the Atlantic Ocean. It is one of the largest mosques in the world and its minaret soars 689 feet into the sky and part of the mosques floor is made of glass so worshippers can kneel directly over the ocean's waters. We continue onto the red oasis city of Marrakesh. This evening enjoy an included dinner.

14.10.17 Marrakesh

(B) The highlight of this morning is the included city sightseeing that will make us feel like we've been whisked back in time. Founded in the 9th century, Marrakesh remains a tapestry of ramparts, mosques, palaces, gardens and vibrant public squares and souks (markets), where buying and selling and a carnival of entertainment and fascinations occur daily.

15.10.17 Marrakesh - Fez

(B/D) Today we travel through the fragrant cedar forests of the Middle Atlas Mountains, where a number of peaks soar above 13,000 feet in elevation. This range is home to the endangered Barbary Ape as well as wild boar and polecats. On our way north to Fez, enjoy glimpses of North African village life reminiscent of Beau Geste. This evening enjoy an included dinner.

16.10.17 Fez

(B) Ancient Fez is a city of outstanding scenic beauty. This morning we visit the Medina and enjoy the maze of narrow streets through the colourful bazaars and the exotic atmosphere. The madrasas, fondouks, palaces, residences, mosques and fountains dating back to the 13th century are now UNESCO World Heritage sites. The afternoon is at leisure to explore at your own pace.

17.10.17 Fez - Ferry to Spain – Costa del Sol

(B/D) This morning we have an early departure north for the ferry back to mainland Spain to the Costa del Sol (Coast of the Sun). This evening enjoy an included dinner.

18.10.17 Costa Del Sol - Granada, Spain

(B/D) This morning we drive along the Costa del Sol and head to Granada, in the heart of Andalusia. We have an included guided visit of the Alhambra, a lavish palace and fortress complex built by Moorish kings. With construction dating back to 889 A.D. we will marvel at its architectural beauty and magnificent gardens. The remainder of the day is at leisure. This evening enjoy an included dinner.

19.10.17 Granada - Madrid

(B) Today we travel north through the very heart of La Mancha, famed for its castle and windmills, before arriving in Madrid. We visit a local wine cellar and taste some of the locally produced wines.

20.10.17 Madrid - Dubai

(B) This morning is at leisure, before being transferred to the airport for our flight to Dubai. Depart Madrid at 3.20pm on EK 142, arriving in Dubai at 12.45am. Upon arrival in Dubai we are met and transferred to the Metropolitan Hotel for a three night stay.

21.10.17 **Dubai**

This morning is at leisure to relax after our late arrival in Dubai. In the afternoon there is a city sightseeing tour. Sample the historic sites and vibrant cosmopolitan life of Dubai on this comprehensive tour. The tour starts with a photo stop at the iconic landmark of Dubai, Burj Al Arab, which is a luxury hotel standing on an artificial island. The shape of the building is designed to mimic the sail of a ship. Proceed to Jumeirah, the picturesque palace and residential area of Dubai, which is also home to the impressive Jumeirah Mosque. The tour continues to Al Bastakiya, the old part of Dubai, to reach the museum located in Al Fahidi Fort. Afterwards we board the Abra (water taxi) to cross the creek to the spice souk. On our return there is time to shop in the most famous market of Dubai, the gold souk. The souk consists of over 300 retailers that trade almost exclusively in jewellery. By some estimates, approximately 10 tons of gold are present at any given time in the souk.

22.10.17 Dubai

(B/D) Today is at leisure. In the evening we enjoy a fabulous, relaxing Dhow Cruise with dinner. We join a traditional Arabian dhow for a journey with a contrast of the old and new Dubai, while we cruise on Dubai Creek. Enjoy a sumptuous feast of Arabic and International cuisine while gently gliding past illuminated souks, banks and palaces.

23.10.17 Dubai - Australia


